Strong supporters of the NOAA Fisheries right whale education efforts with the shipping industry, the pilots began carrying right whale placards, videos, and information on board vessels in 2002 to help masters understand the vulnerability of these endangered whales to collisions with ships, and to increase awareness of their endangered status. The NE Marine Pilots also provide masters with recent right whale locations and guidance on the Right Whale Mandatory Reporting Ship (MSR) System requirements.

"On behalf of the 12,500 men and women working for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, I am pleased to present you with this 2004 Environmental Hero Award," Lautenbacher wrote in a letter to the recipients. "Your dedicated efforts and outstanding accomplishments greatly benefit the environment and make our nation a better place for all Americans."
