Subject: New Hospice rates effective October 1, 2008

Effective October 1, 2008, DMAP will update the Medicaid payment rates for the Hospice Services program. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) update these rates annually, based on the annual Medicare hospice rates. The new rates are for care and services provided from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009.

The full rate schedule follows. Please note that when billing for hospice services, you must bill the usual charge or the rate based on the geographic area where care is furnished, whichever is lower, in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 410-142-0300(1).

Hospice Rates

Effective October 1, 2008. Follow CMS guidelines.

When billing for hospice services, the provider must bill the usual charge or the rate based upon the geographic location in which the care is furnished, whichever is lower.
