"On the Move in Oregon" is Oregon's Money Follows the Person project. Through "On the Move", about 1,000 people who live in Oregon's nursing facilities – children, adults with disabilities and seniors – will receive the services and supports that they need to move back into their homes and communities.



The project will be managed by the Seniors and People with Disabilities Division (SPD) of the Department of Human Services. People will start moving during the second quarter of this year. Project funding for people who move will be available through September 30, 2011.
