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Individual Tasks	Accuracy	Safety
<b>1. Starting</b>		
*Driver checks to be sure all compartment doors are closed *Driver checks and adjusts mirrors *Driver depresses clutch and places gear shift into neutral *Driver gets vehicle in motion without killing engine *Driver starts in lowest gear and does not race engine		
<b>2. Hills - Start - Stop</b>		
*Driver ascends hills in proper gear *Driver stops on hill and starts without rolling back more than one (1) foot *Driver uses emergency brake correctly		
<b>3. Driving on Streets</b>		
*Driver comes to a full stop prior to entering controlled intersection *Driver looks left and right at all intersections *Driver shifts up and down smoothly *Driver shifts to proper gear for prevailing conditions		
<b>4. Backing and Parking</b>		
*Evaluator instructs driver on what to do and then dismounts from cab to observe backing operation *Driver uses caution in backing, positions lookout at rear *Driver finds reverse gear without hesitation *Driver secures clear vision of area *Driver spots apparatus at curb and out of traffic lane *Driver uses wheel blocks		
<b>5. General</b>		
*Driver used seat belts *Driver's treatment of the engine - no unnecessary speed increases, lugging under load, revving before shutting down *Driver's ability to stop apparatus smoothly *Driver's exhibition of responsibility and concern for safety of apparatus and personnel while driving apparatus *Driver was alert and attentive		

HOW TO EVALUATE PERFORMANCE:

ACCURACY: 100. Performed task with 100% accuracy and no hesitation  
90. Performed task very accurately and little hesitation  
Pass 80. Performed task satisfactorily, with minimal hesitation  
Fail 70. Performed task minimally, needs to improve. (Retake task one time)  
69 or below: Unable to perform the task. (Fail and retake every task)

SAFETY: 100. Extremely safety conscious  
90. Safe operation  
Pass 80. Safe operation with minor oversights  
Fail 70. Needs to make some definite safety improvements (Retake one time)  
69 or below: Reckless or negligent (Fail and retake every task)

SCORING: A score of 80 or above is required to pass any task: this is not a cumulative score.  
A score below 80 on any task: may retake up to 2 tasks on the same day.  
A score of 69 or below must retake all tasks on another date.  
If below 80 on second time: must redo the entire test on another date.  
If fail same task twice: retake entire test another date.  
A maximum of two tasks may be retaken in one day.
