Upcoming Road Maintenance Projects

John Day – Malheur National Forest Supervisor Doug Gochnour announces several road maintenance projects starting up this month. Occasional short delays on these roads may occur. Please use caution while traveling these routes during these construction times.

August 5, Forest Service personnel will be power brooming Forest Road 13 on the Prairie City Ranger District and will power broom the first 6.6 miles of Forest Road 41 on the Emigrant Creek Ranger District from County Road 127 beginning the week of August 11.

August 11, Paving will begin at the Huddelston Snow Park, Prairie City Ranger District, duration 2 days.

August 13-15, Patching on Forest Road 21 (Fields Creek), Blue Mountain Ranger District, from Highway 26 South to the intersection of Forest Road 2170.

August 18-22, Trucks will be hauling rock on Forest Road 41 on Emigrant Creek Ranger District from Forest Service Road 4335 junction to Forest Service Road 4115 Junction.

August 25-27, Chip seal process on Forest Road 13 on the Prairie City Ranger District, from Forest Road 16 junction.

September 2-5, Chip seal on Forest Road 41 on the Emigrant Creek Ranger District, from County Road 127 to Forest Road 4115.
