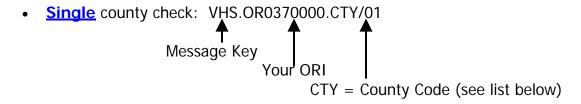
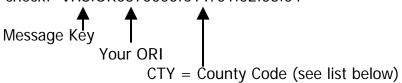
## New format available to all Oregon Law Enforcement Agencies who have access to Law Enforcement Data Systems (LEDS).

LEDS now offers a vehicle "Hot Sheet" capability that allows users to run a list of vehicles entered as stolen in a county during the past 24 hours. The query may include up to four counties per transaction.

Examples of the query format appear below:



• Multiple county check: VHS.OR0370000.CTY/01.02.03.04



Here is an example of an actual VHS transaction using multiple agencies:
