

SECTION 1

STATEWIDE SUMMARY

This section presents an overview of Statewide Statistics relating to criminal Offenses and Arrests for 1996.

SUMMARY

CRIME IN OREGON

Crime in Oregon decreased 4.4% in 1996 when compared to 1995. Crime decreased in 23 of the 36 counties in Oregon

Crime in the five major populated counties is depicted in this summary as a visual overview of crime in Oregon. The counties of Clackamas, Lane, Marion, Multnomah and Washington represent 59.6% of the State's population. These 5 counties reported 61.0% of the total crime in Oregon and 64.5% of the total Crimes Against Persons.

OREGON POPULATION

Population estimates for Oregon are provided by the Center of Population Research and Census, Portland State University. Total Oregon population for 1996 Statistics is 3,181,000.

CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons decreased 9.9% from 1995 to 1996.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Willful Homicide, Negligent Homicide, Rape, Other Sex Crimes, Kidnapping, Robbery, Aggravated Assault and Simple Assault all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

There were no increases in any major crime against persons categories.

There were 28 more Bank Robberies reported in 1996 compared to 1995.

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property decreased 6.4% from 1995 to 1996.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, Arson, Forgery/Counterfeiting, Fraud, Stolen Property Offenses (Possession, buy, sell) and Vandalism all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Embezzlement reported an increase.

BEHAVIORAL CRIMES

Behavioral Crimes increased 1.3% from 1995 to 1996.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Weapons Offenses, Drug Laws, Offenses Against Family, Disorderly Conduct and Runaway all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Prostitution, Gambling, D U I I, Liquor Laws, "All Other", and curfew all reported increases.

INDEX CRIME RATE

The Index Crime Rate for 1996 was 606.4 crimes per 10,000 population. This is a 9.0% decrease from the rate of 666.5 for 1995. These rates are based on estimated population of 3,181,000 for 1996 and 3,132,000 for 1995.

ARRESTS IN OREGON

Arrests = 175,318 (This excludes arrests for Traffic Crime, Fish & Game, or Marine)

The total number of arrests increased 2.9%.

Arrests of Males increased 4.1%

Arrests of Females increased 5.2%

Arrests of Adults (persons 18 years and older) increased 1.3%

Arrests of Juveniles (persons 17 years and younger) increased 7.3%

The increase in arrests of juveniles is reflected in all categories of crime and most geographical areas of the state.

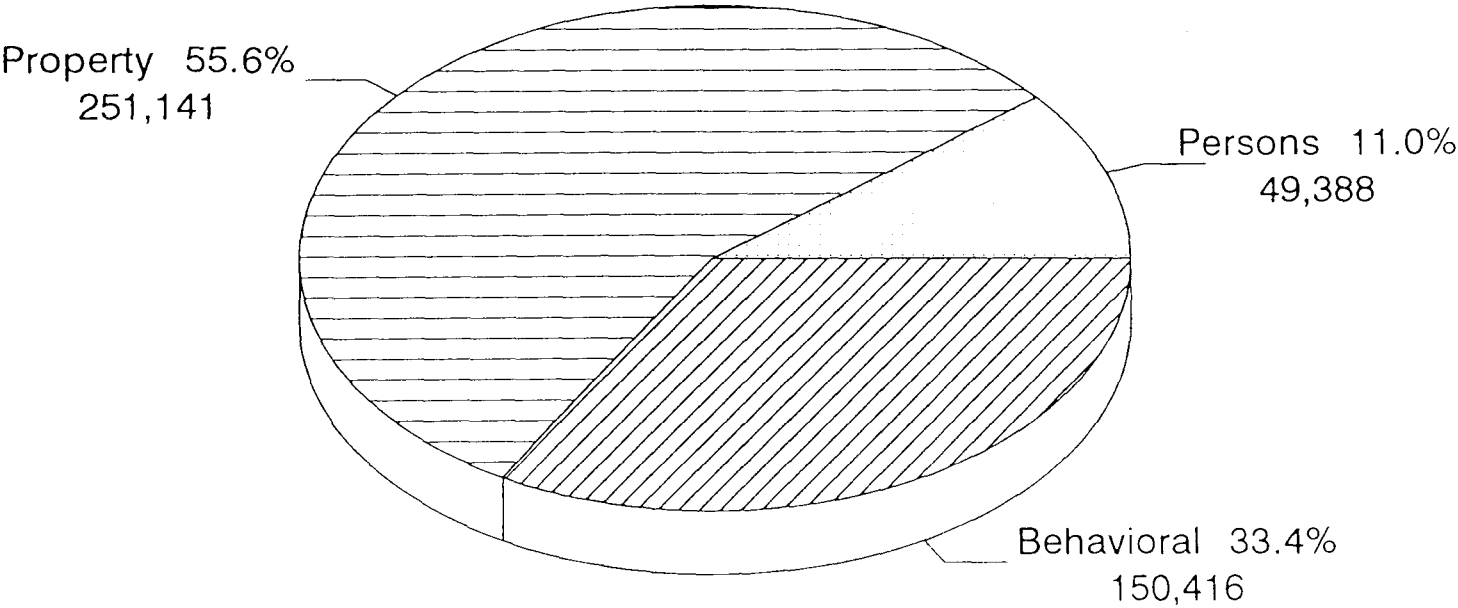
The increase in arrests of adults is reflected in all categories of crime.

1996 CRIMINAL OFFENSES by POPULATION CENTER

The cities of Portland, Salem and Eugene, combined have 23.6% of the Oregon population and reported 38.3% of the Crimes Against Persons, 34.7% of the Crimes Against Property, 25.8% of Behavioral Crimes and 32.1% of the Crime Total.

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Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, Marion and Lane Counties contain 59.6% of the State's population and reported 61.0% of the Crime Total.

January through December 1996

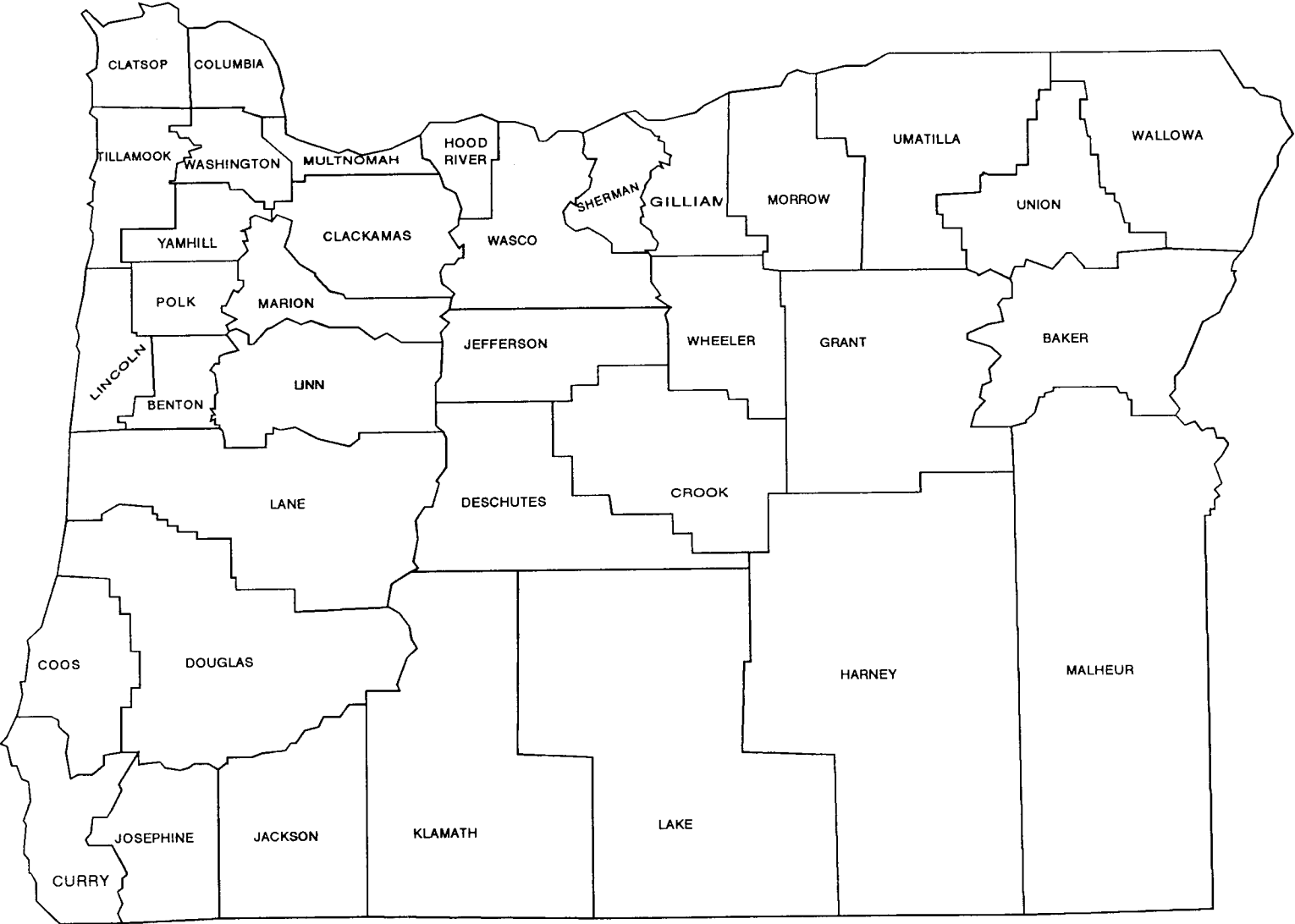

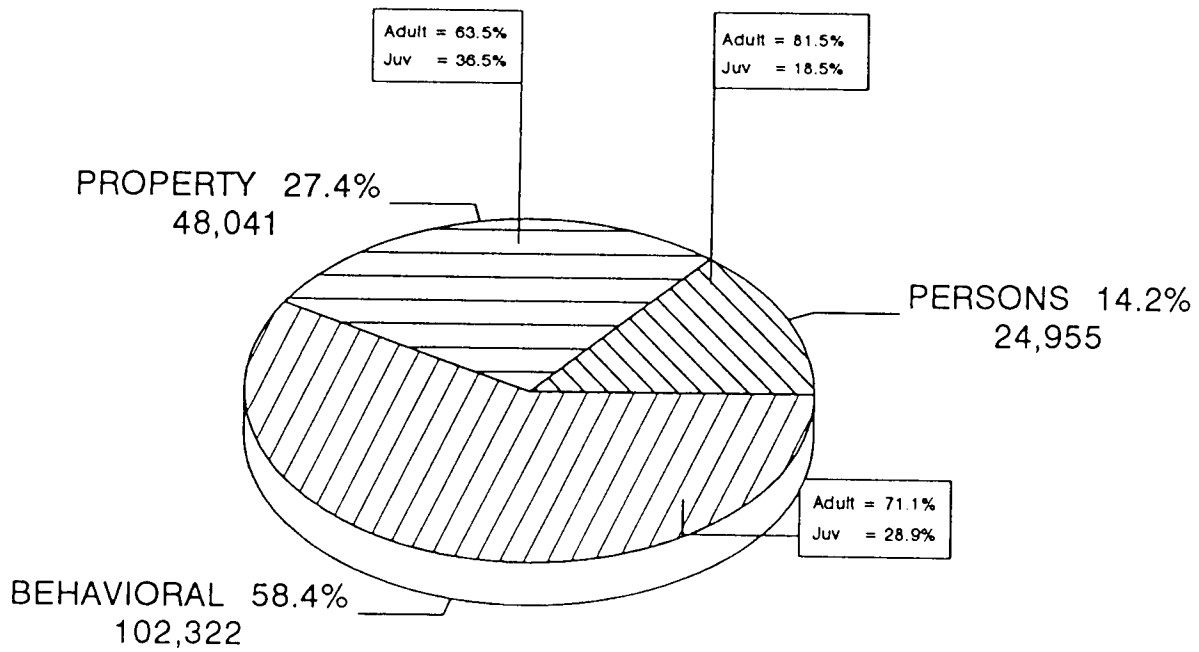
OREGON COUNTY MAP

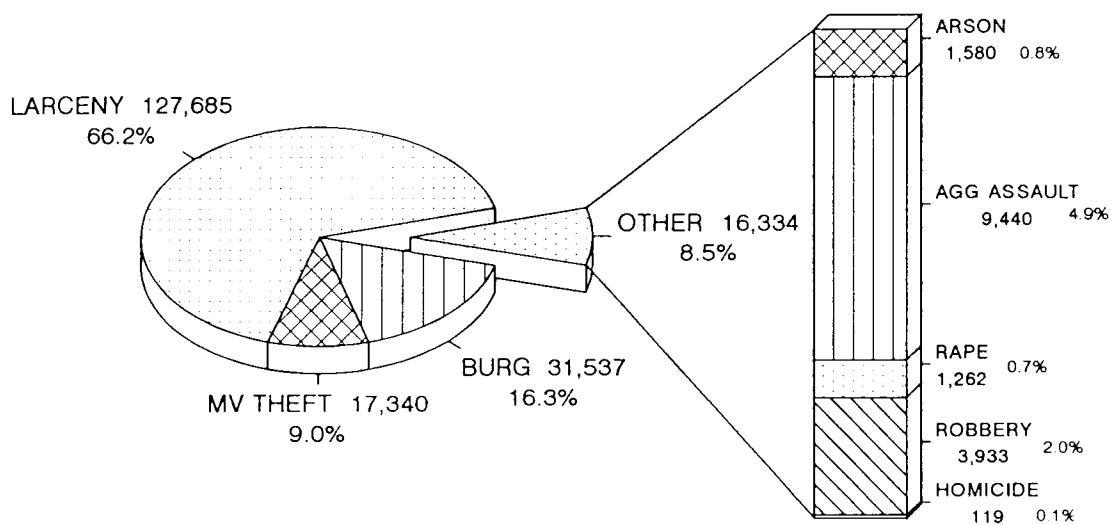

TOTAL REPORTED INDEX CRIME OFFENSES January through December 1996

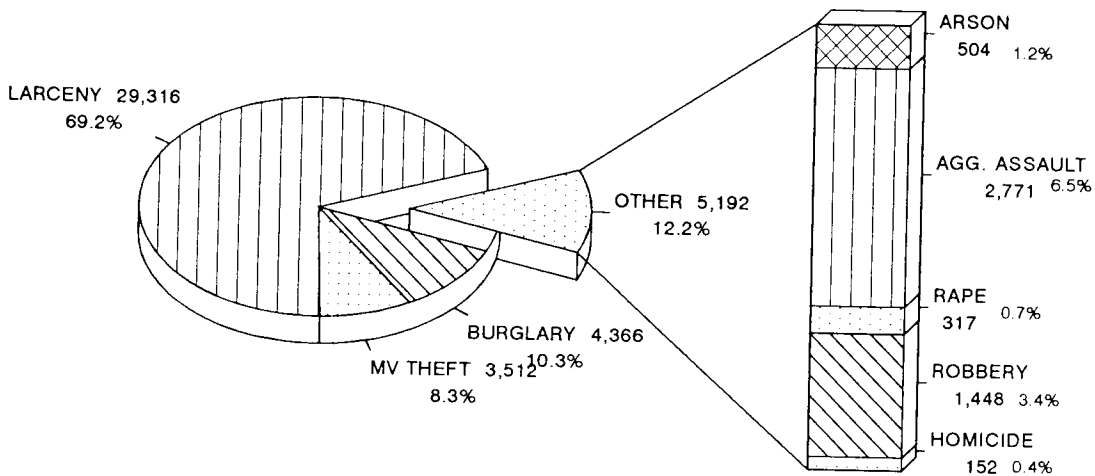

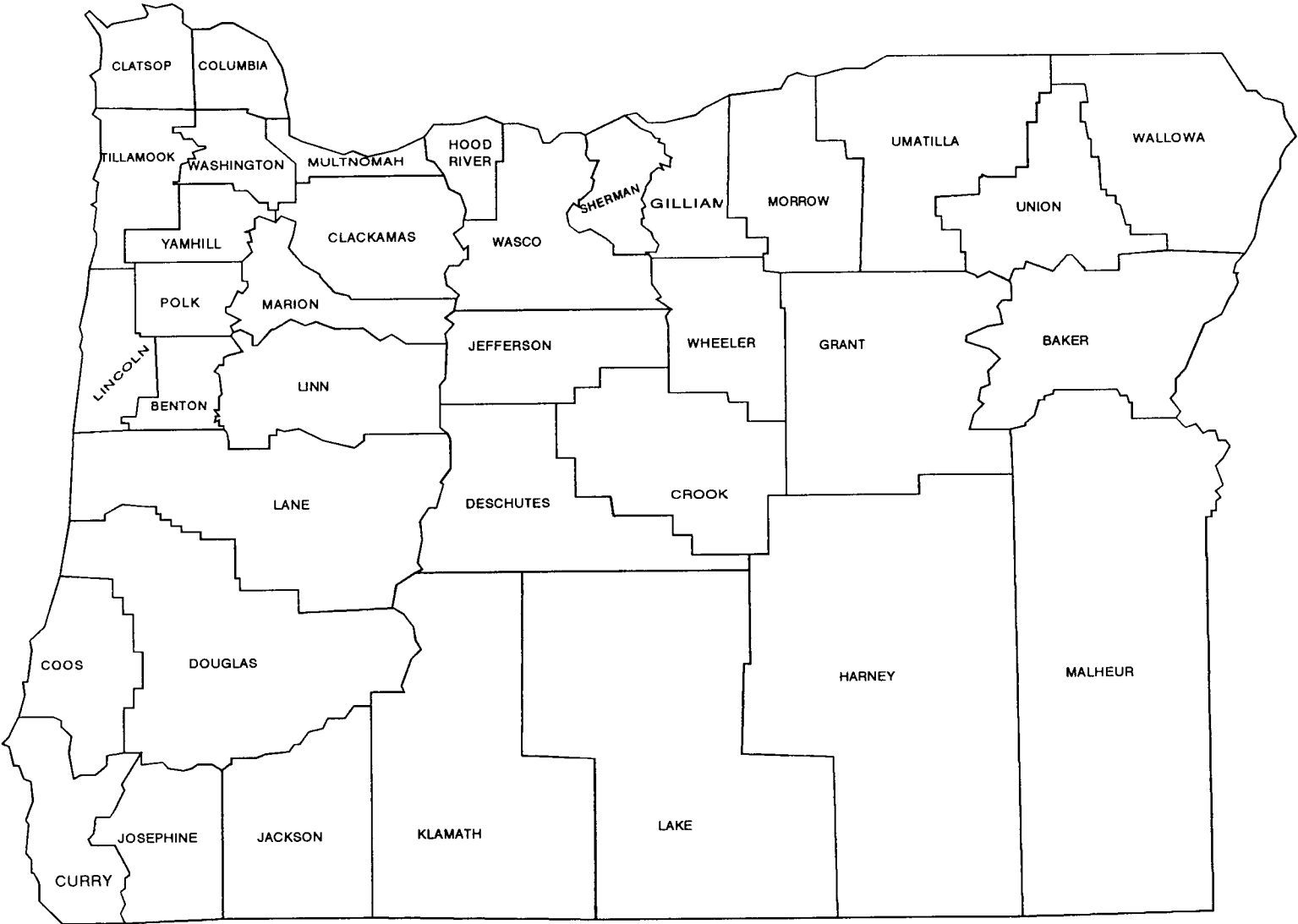

OREGON BIAS CRIME STATISTICS SUMMARY

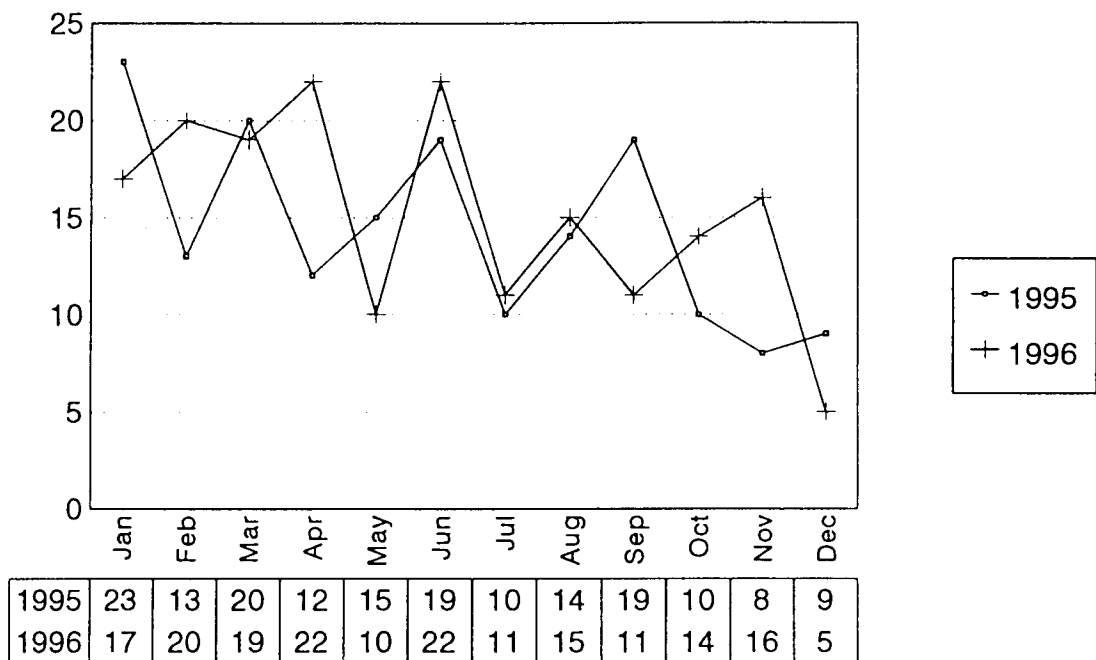
January through December 1996

The 1989 Oregon Legislature passed Senate Bill 606, amending ORS 181.550, requiring law enforcement agencies to report crimes motivated by prejudice to the State Executive Department, Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS). Law Enforcement agencies report these Bias Crime incidents by sending a copy of the police report to LEDS. The 1995 legislature passed Senate Bill 1044 which moved the Law Enforcement Data System from the Executive Department to the Department of Oregon State Police. This transfer included the Uniform Crime Reporting and Bias Crime Reporting Programs.

The number of bias crimes reported for 1996 increased 5.8% from the number reported for 1995.

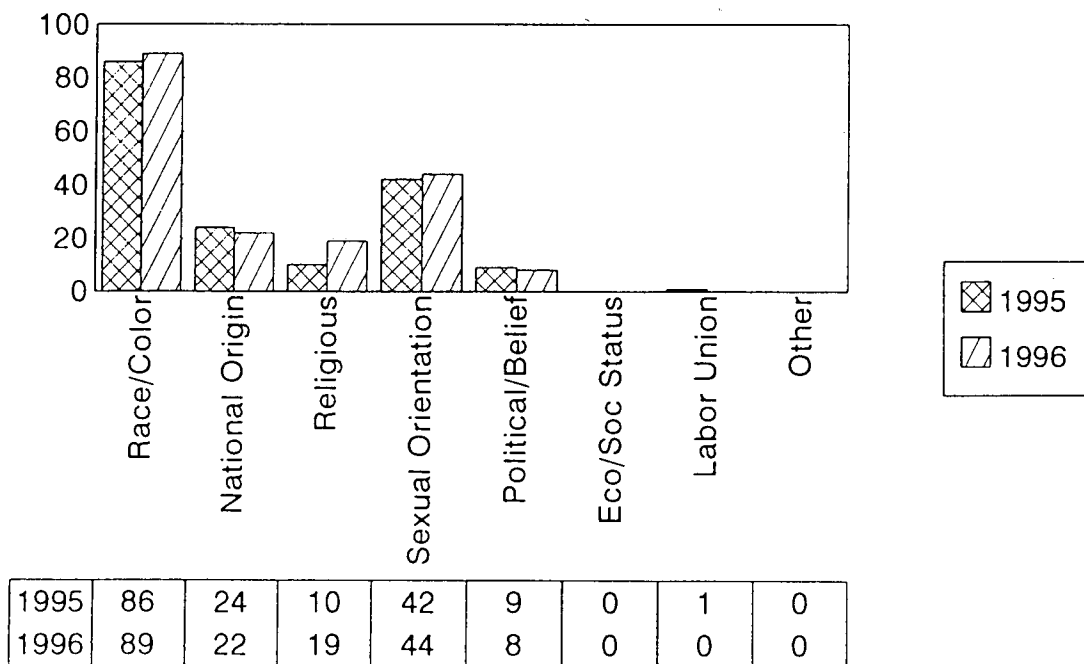
Bias Crime

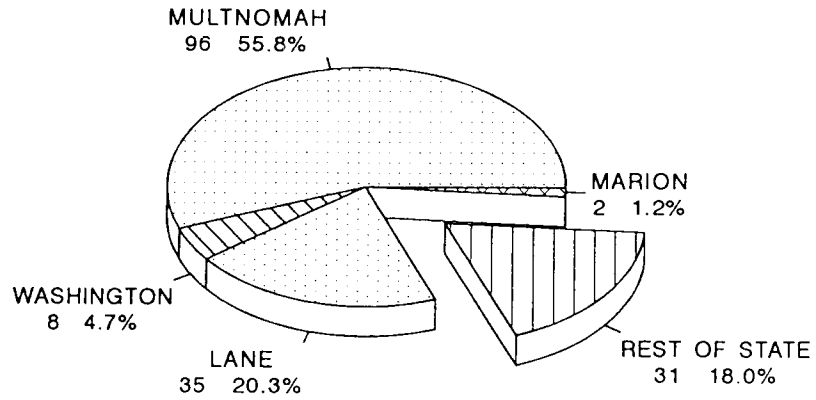

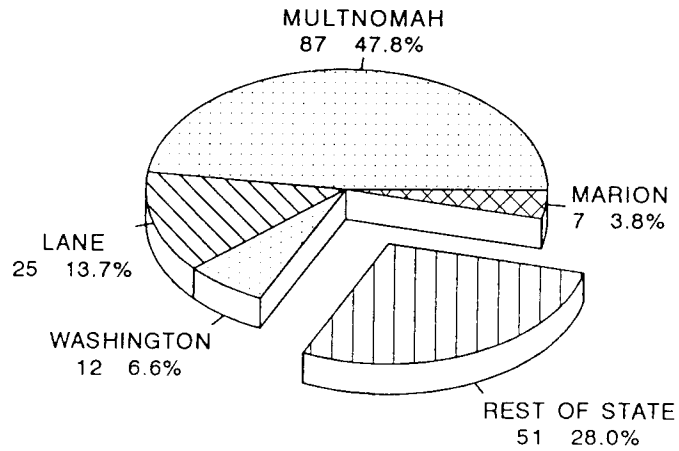
CRIMES MOTIVATED BY PREJUDICE by County Jan-Dec 1995 and 1996

ORS 181.550 directs all Oregon law enforcement agencies to report all statistics regarding incidents arising out of Domestic Disturbances under ORS 133.055 (2) and 133.310 (3) to the Department of State Police. An interim program of manual reporting has been implemented on a quarterly basis beginning with the last quarter of 1994.

The county summary on the following pages represents the results of reports from 155 agencies, covering 97.7% of Oregon's population.
