

SECTION 1
STATEWIDE SUMMARY

This section presents an overview of Statewide Statistics relating to criminal Offenses and Arrests for 1999.

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SUMMARY

CRIME IN OREGON

Crime in Oregon decreased 4.7% in 1999 when compared to 1998. Crime increased in 5 of the 36 counties in Oregon.

Crime in the five major populated counties is depicted in this summary as a visual overview of crime in Oregon. The counties of Clackamas, Lane, Marion, Multnomah and Washington represent 59.7% of the State's population. These 5 counties reported 61.0% of the total crime in Oregon and 65.1% of the total Crimes Against Persons.

OREGON POPULATION

Population estimates for Oregon are provided by the Center of Population Research and Census, Portland State University. Total Oregon population for 1999 statistics is 3,300,800.

CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons decreased 4.8% from 1998 to 1999.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Willful Homicide, Negligent Homicide, Rape, Kidnapping, Robbery, Aggravated Assault and Simple Assault all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Other Sex Crimes reported an increase.

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property decreased 8.0% from 1998 to 1999.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, Arson, Forgery/Counterfeiting, Stolen Property Offenses (Possession, buy, sell) and Vandalism all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Fraud and Embezzlement reported increases.

BEHAVIORAL CRIMES

Behavioral Crimes increased 0.4% from 1998 to 1999.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Weapons Offenses, Prostitution, Gambling, Offenses Against Family, Disorderly Conduct, "All Other", Curfew and Runaway all reported decreases.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Drug Laws, D.U.I.I. and Liquor Laws reported increases.

INDEX CRIME RATE

The Index Crime Rate for 1999 was 511.2 crimes per 10,000 population. This is a 11.1% decrease from the rate of 575.3 for 1998. These rates are based on estimated population of 3,300,800 for 1999 and 3,267,550 for 1998.

ARRESTS IN OREGON

Arrests = 165,981 (This excludes arrests for Traffic Crime, Fish & Game, or Marine)

The total number of arrests decreased 3.3%.

Arrests of Adults (persons 18 years and older) decreased 0.8%.

Arrests of Juveniles (persons 17 years and younger) decreased 10.2%.

Arrests of Males decreased 8.8%.

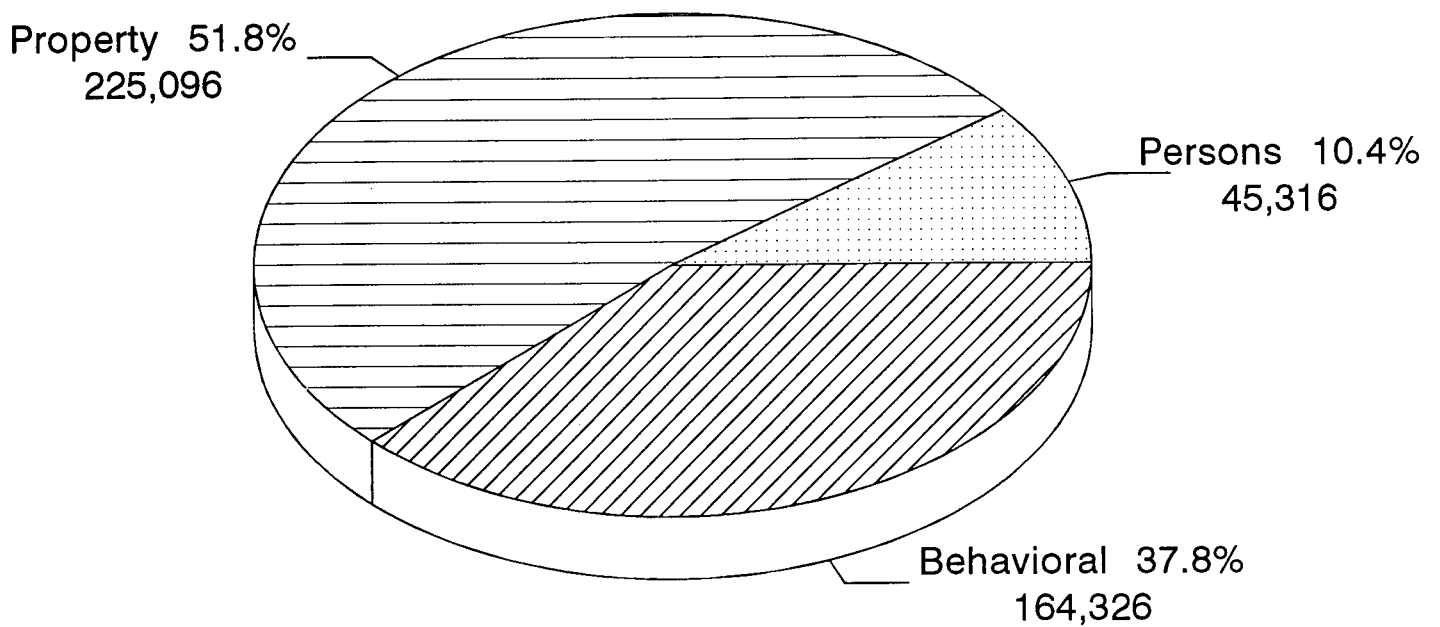
Arrests of Females decreased 7.0%.

1999 CRIMINAL OFFENSES by POPULATION CENTER

The cities of Portland, Salem and Eugene, combined have 23.6% of the Oregon population and reported 37.4% of the Crimes Against Persons, 33.5% of the Crimes Against Property, 27.5% of Behavioral Crimes and 31.7% of the Crime Total.

Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, Marion and Lane Counties contain 59.7% of the State's population and reported 61.0% of the Crime Total.

January through December 1999



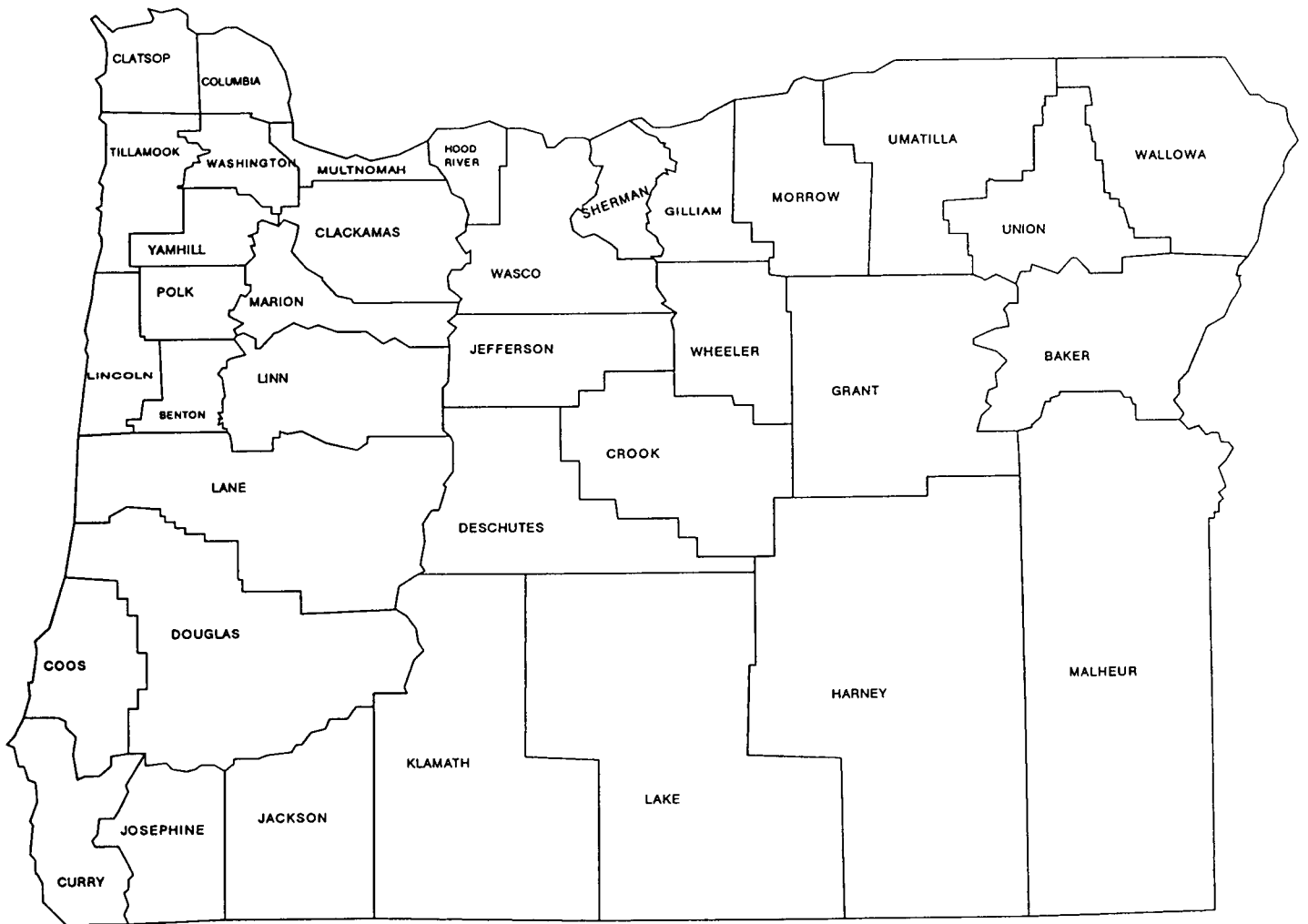

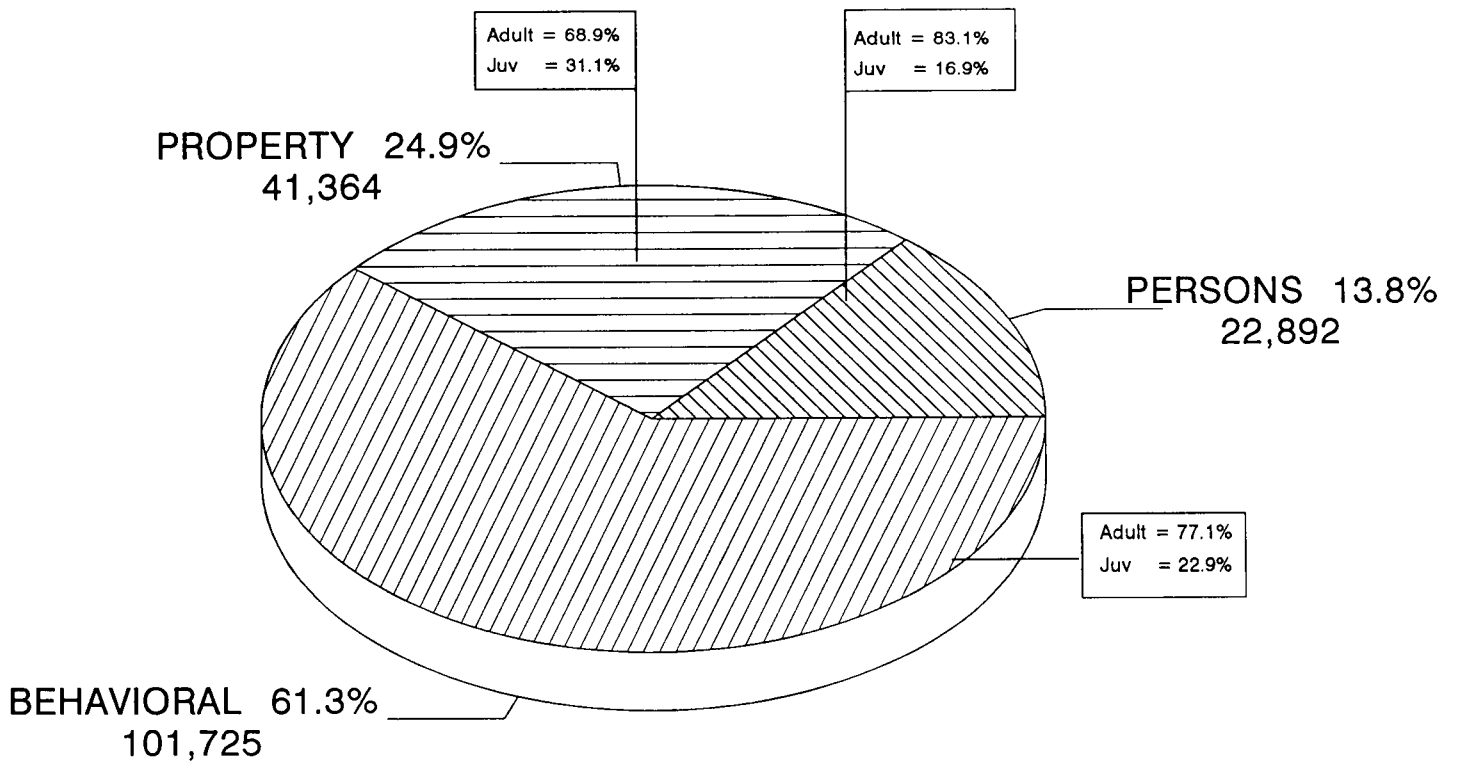
OREGON COUNTY MAP

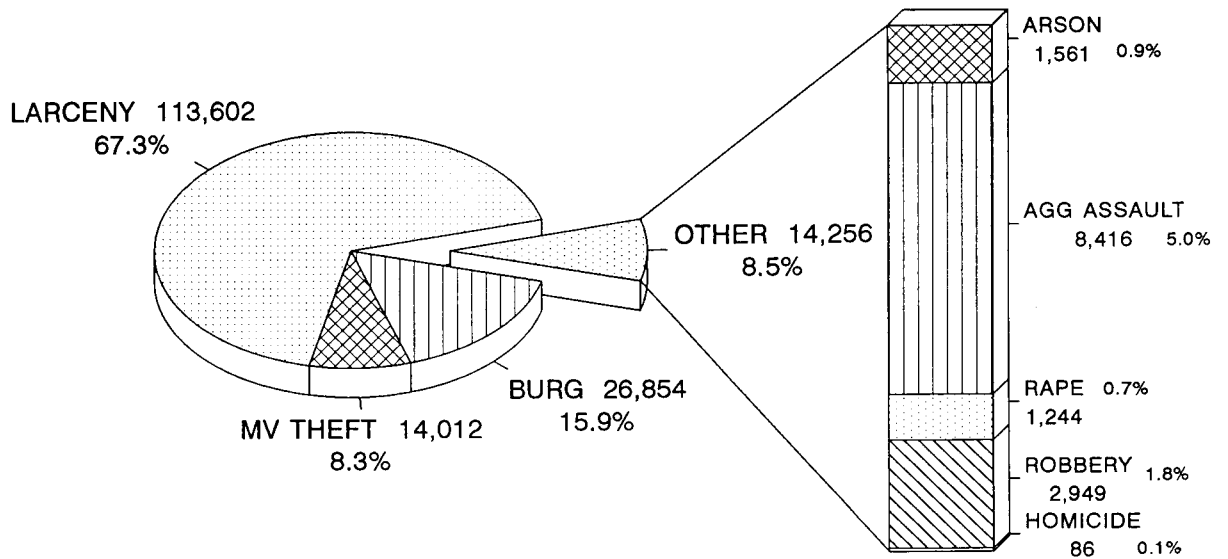

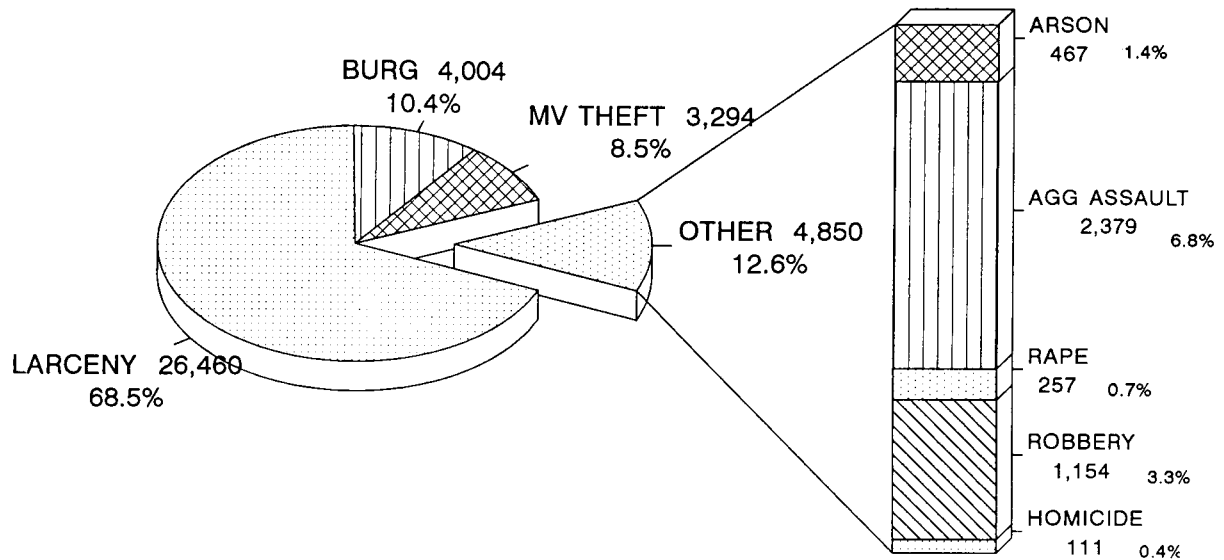

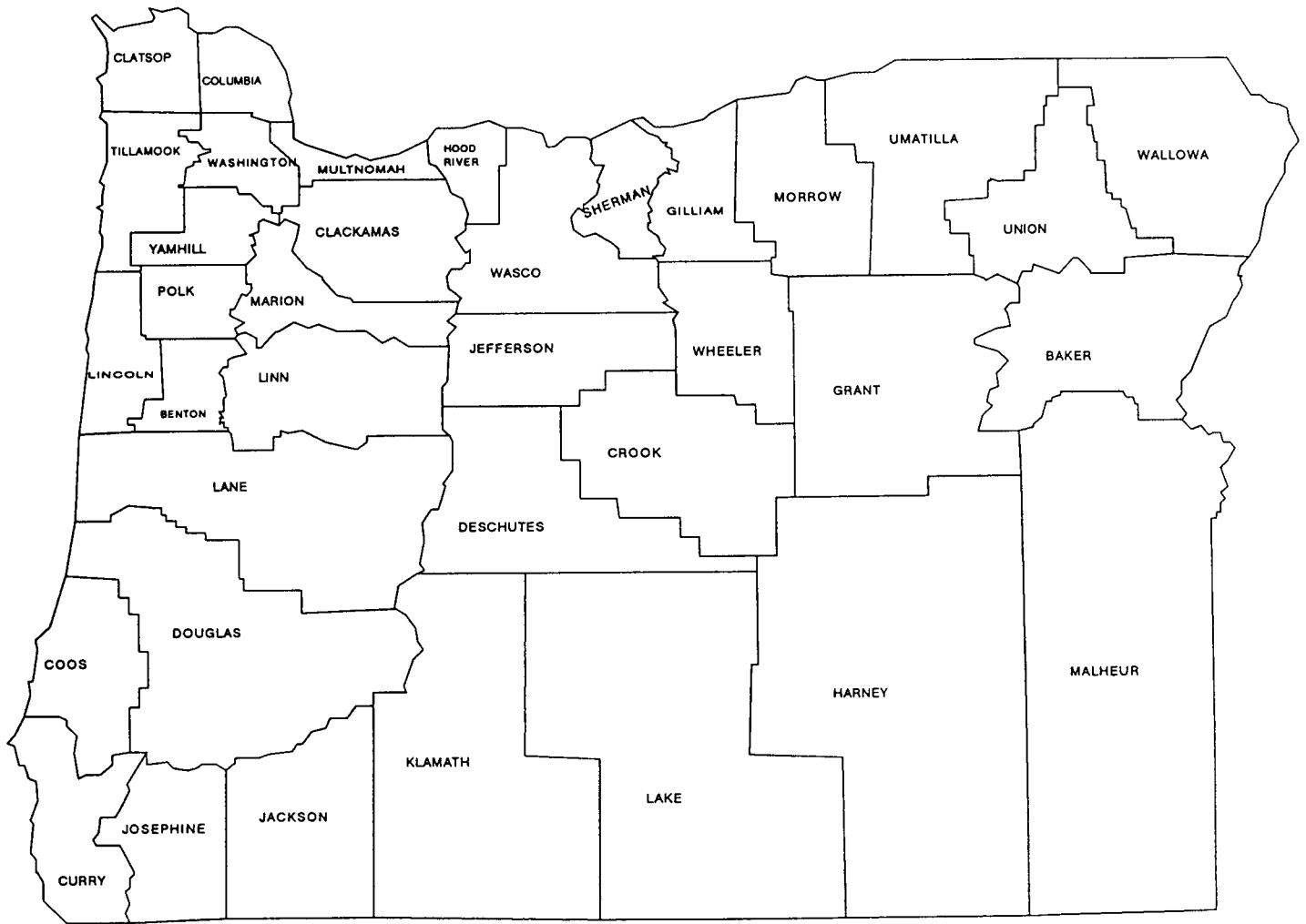

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OREGON BIAS CRIME STATISTICS SUMMARY

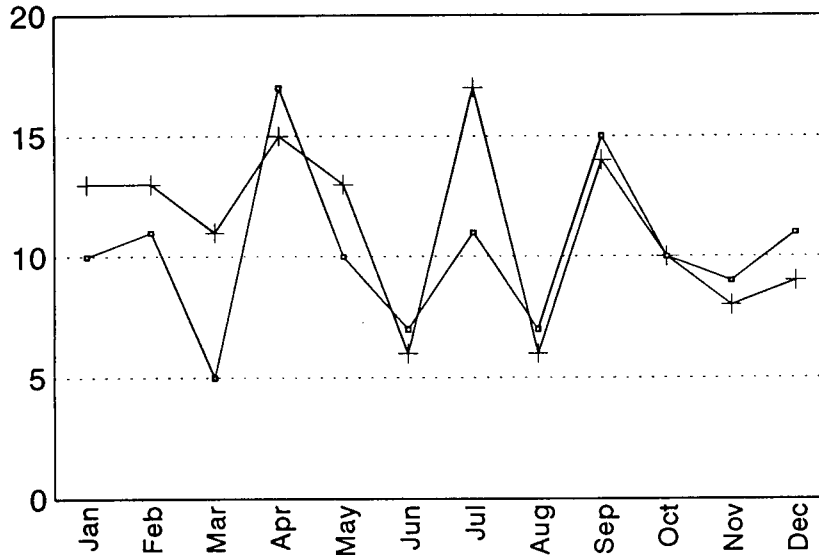
January through December 1999

The 1989 Oregon Legislature passed Senate Bill 606, amending ORS 181.550, requiring law enforcement agencies to report crimes motivated by prejudice to the State Executive Department, Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS). Law Enforcement agencies report these Bias Crime incidents by sending a copy of the police report to LEDS. The 1995 legislature passed Senate Bill 1044 which moved the Law Enforcement Data System from the Executive Department to the Department of Oregon State Police. This transfer included the Uniform Crime Reporting and Bias Crime Reporting Programs.

The number of bias crimes reported for 1998 increased 9.8% from the number reported for 1997.

Bias Crime

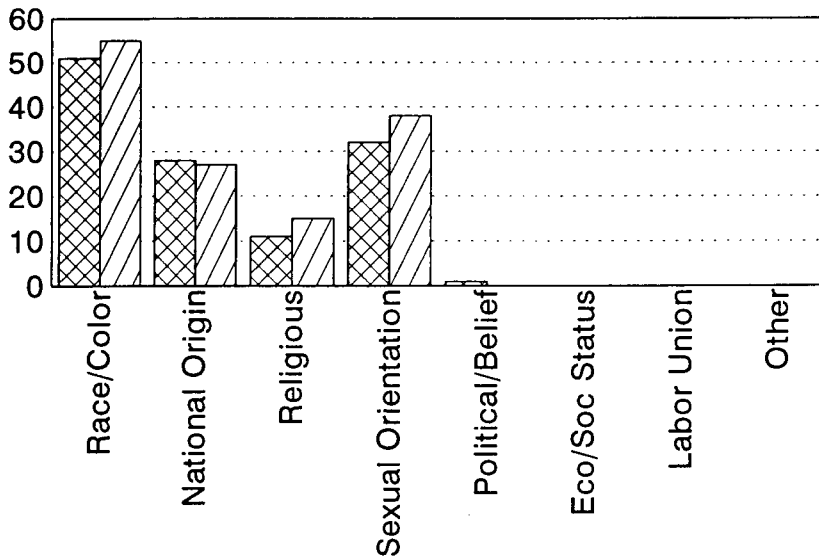
Totals By Month Jan-Dec 1999 Compared to Jan-Dec 1998

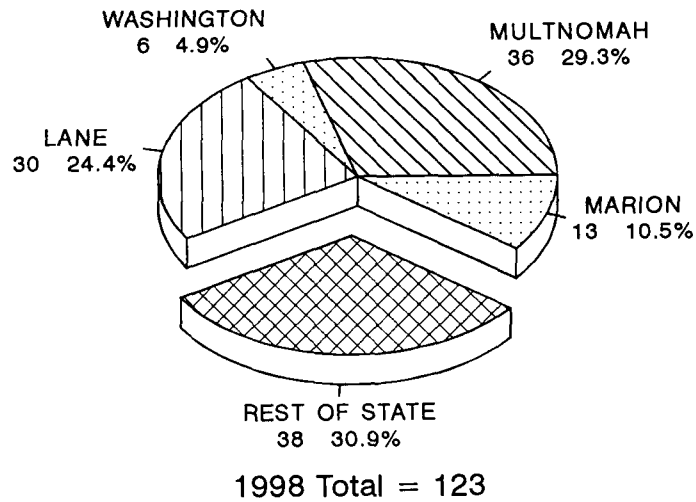

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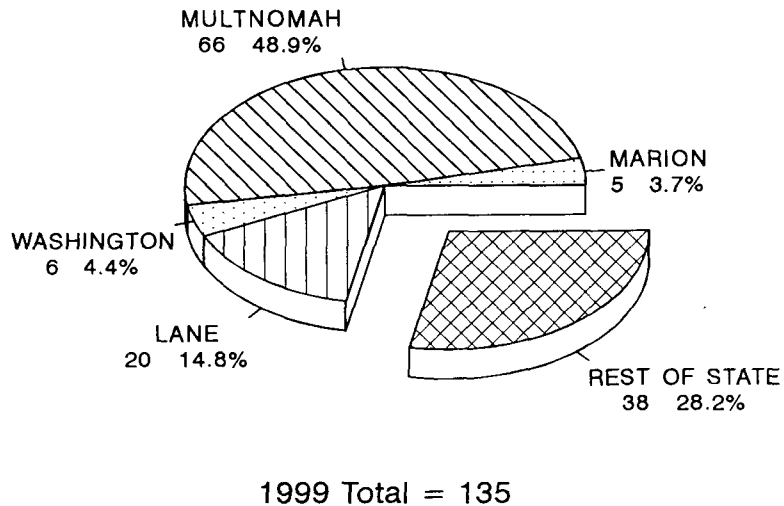

ORS 181.550 directs all Oregon law enforcement agencies to report all statistics regarding incidents arising out of Domestic Disturbances under ORS 133.055 (2) and 133.310 (3) to the Department of State Police. An interim program of manual reporting has been implemented on a quarterly basis beginning with the last quarter of 1994.

The county summary on the following pages represents the results of reports from 152 agencies, covering 89.2% of Oregon's population.
