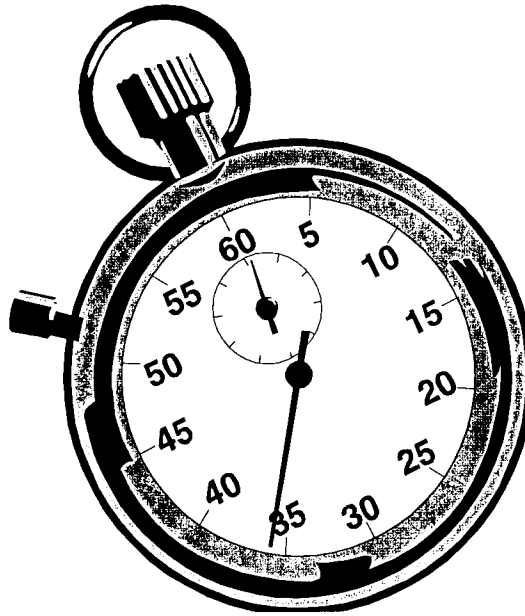

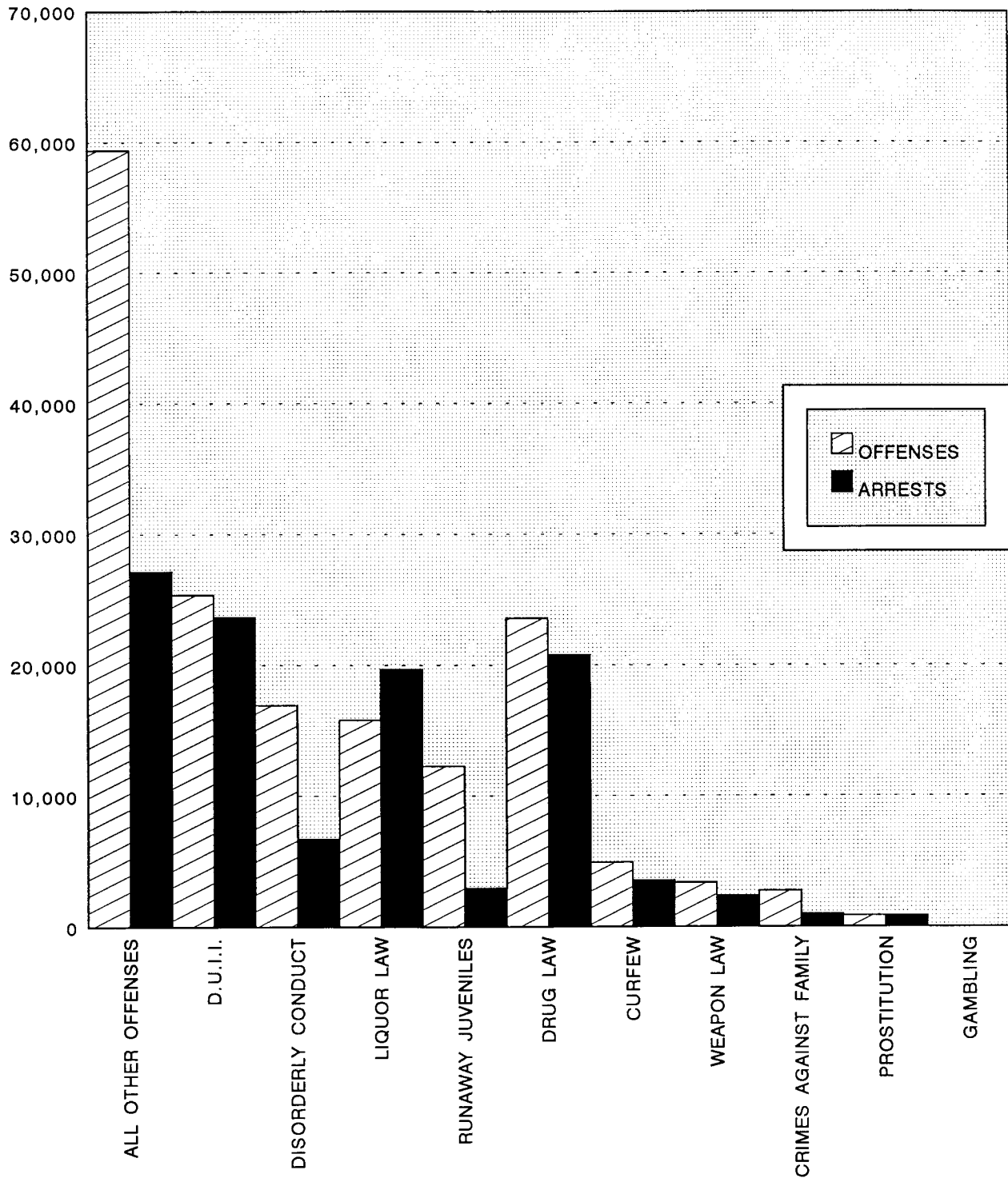

STATEWIDE BEHAVIORAL CRIMES, 2000



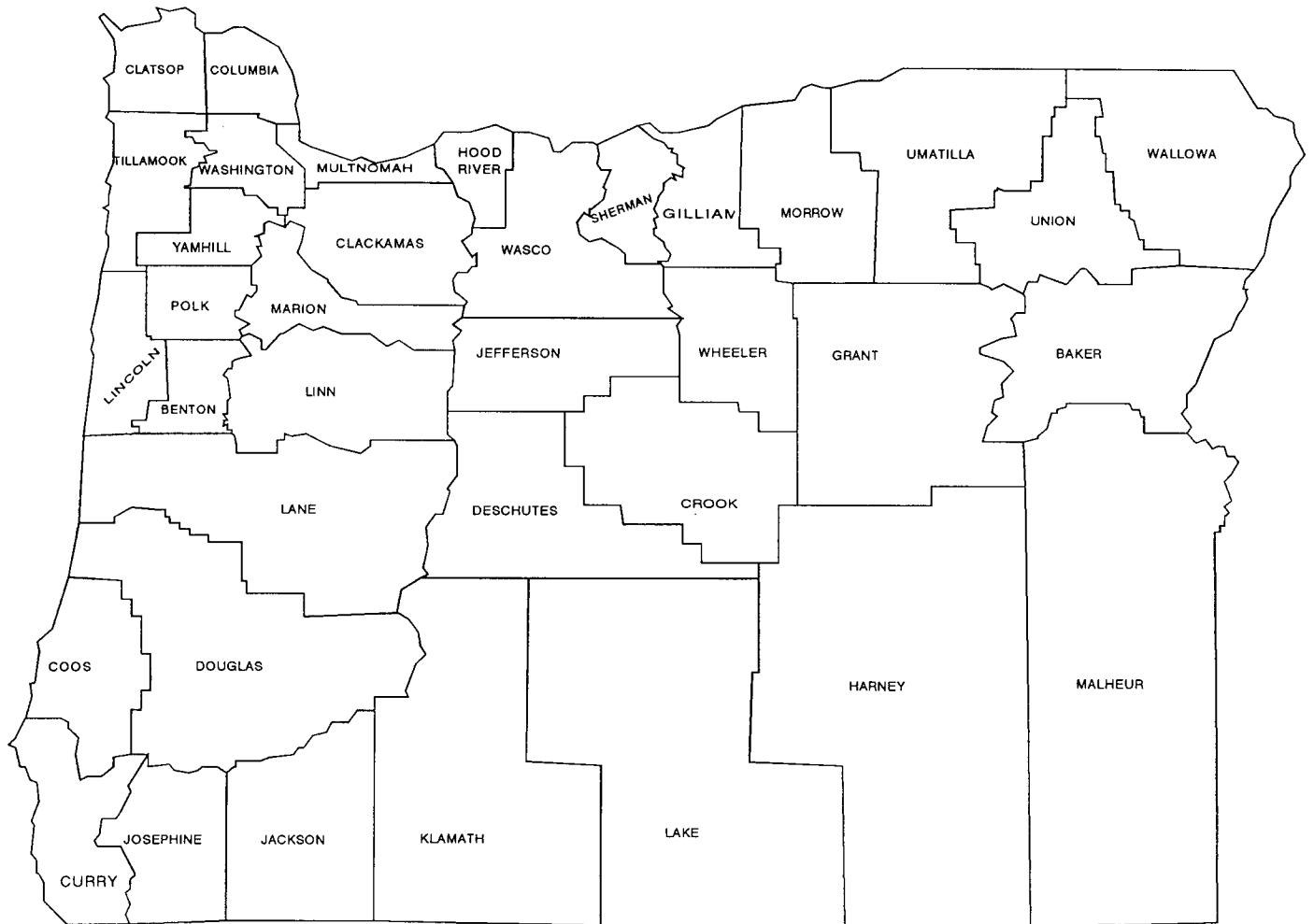

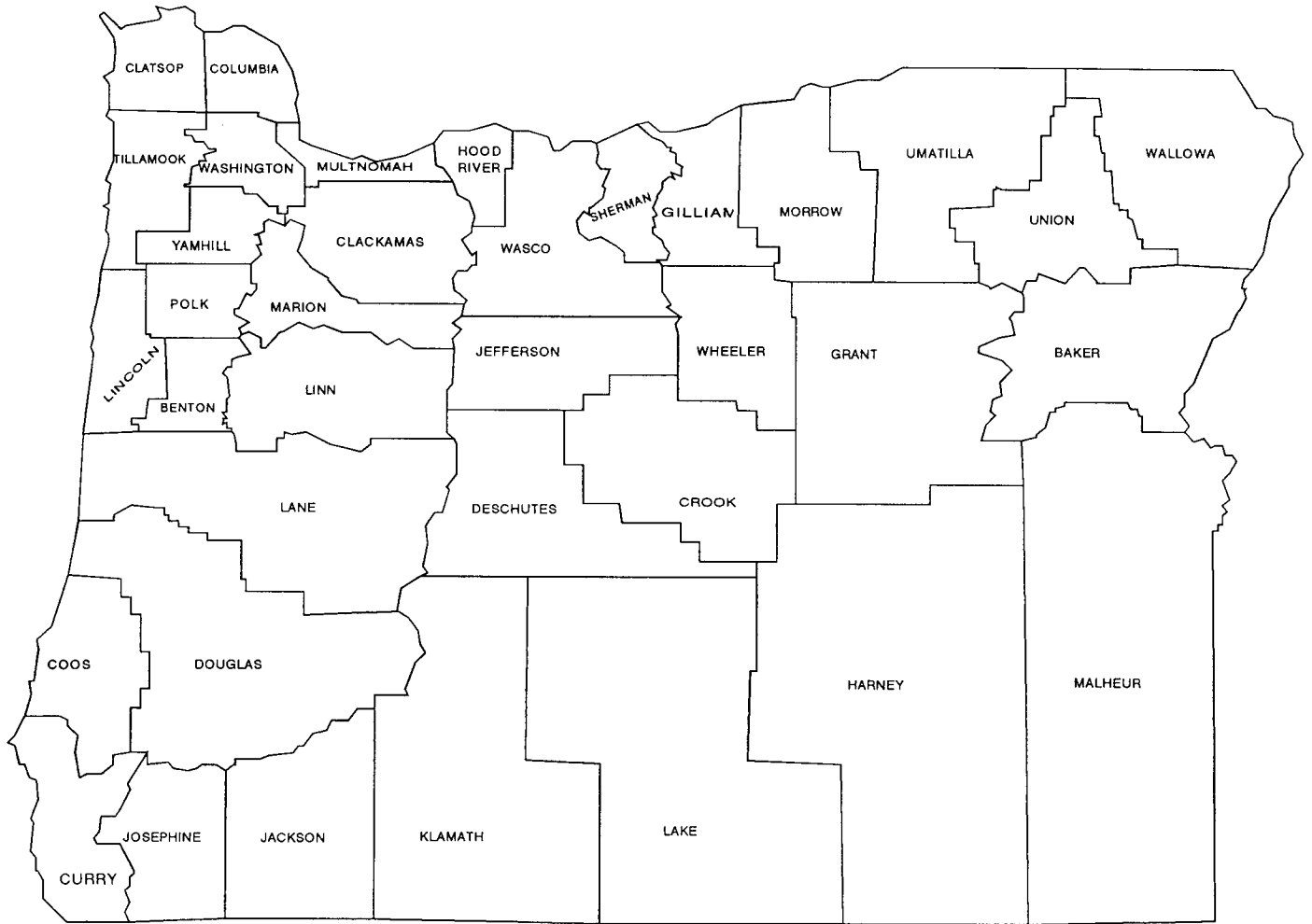
