SUMMARY

CRIME IN OREGON

Crime in Oregon decreased 0.6% overall in 2004 when compared to 2003. Crime increased in 17 of the 36 counties in Oregon.

The counties of Clackamas, Lane, Marion, Multnomah and Washington represent 60.1% of the State's population. These 5 counties reported 59.3% of the total crime in Oregon and 61.5% of the total Crimes Against Persons. If these 5 counties are excluded, crime in the rest of the State actually increased overall by 3.1% in 2004.

OREGON POPULATION

Population estimates for Oregon are provided by the Population Research Center, College of Urban and Public Affairs, Portland State University. Total Oregon population for 2004 statistics is 3,582,600. Population in 2003 was 3,541,500. This is an overall increase in population of 1.2%.

CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons increased 0.5% from 2003 to 2004.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Kidnapping and Simple Assault.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Willful Murder (+26.9%), Negligent Homicide, Rape, Other Sex Offenses, Robbery and Aggravated Assault.

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property decreased 3.2% from 2003 to 2004.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, Arson, Forger/Counterfeiting, Embezzlement and Vandalism.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Burglary, Fraud and Stolen Property (buy, sell, possess).

BEHAVIORAL CRIMES

Behavioral Crimes increased 2.9% from 2003 to 2004.

DECREASES REPORTED:

Gambling, Crimes Against Family and Runaway Juveniles.

INCREASES REPORTED:

Weapon Laws, Prostitution, Drug Laws, D.U.I.I., Liquor Laws, Disorderly Conduct, "All Other" and Curfew.

INDEX CRIME RATE

The Index Crime Rate for 2004 was 507.5 crimes per 10,000 population. This is a 3.5% decrease from the rate of 525.9 for 2003. These rates are based on estimated population of 3,541,500 for 2003 and 3,582,600 for 2004.

ARRESTS IN OREGON

Arrests = 181,878 (This excludes arrests for Traffic Crime, Fish & Game, or Marine)

The total number of arrests increased 10.6% in 2004.

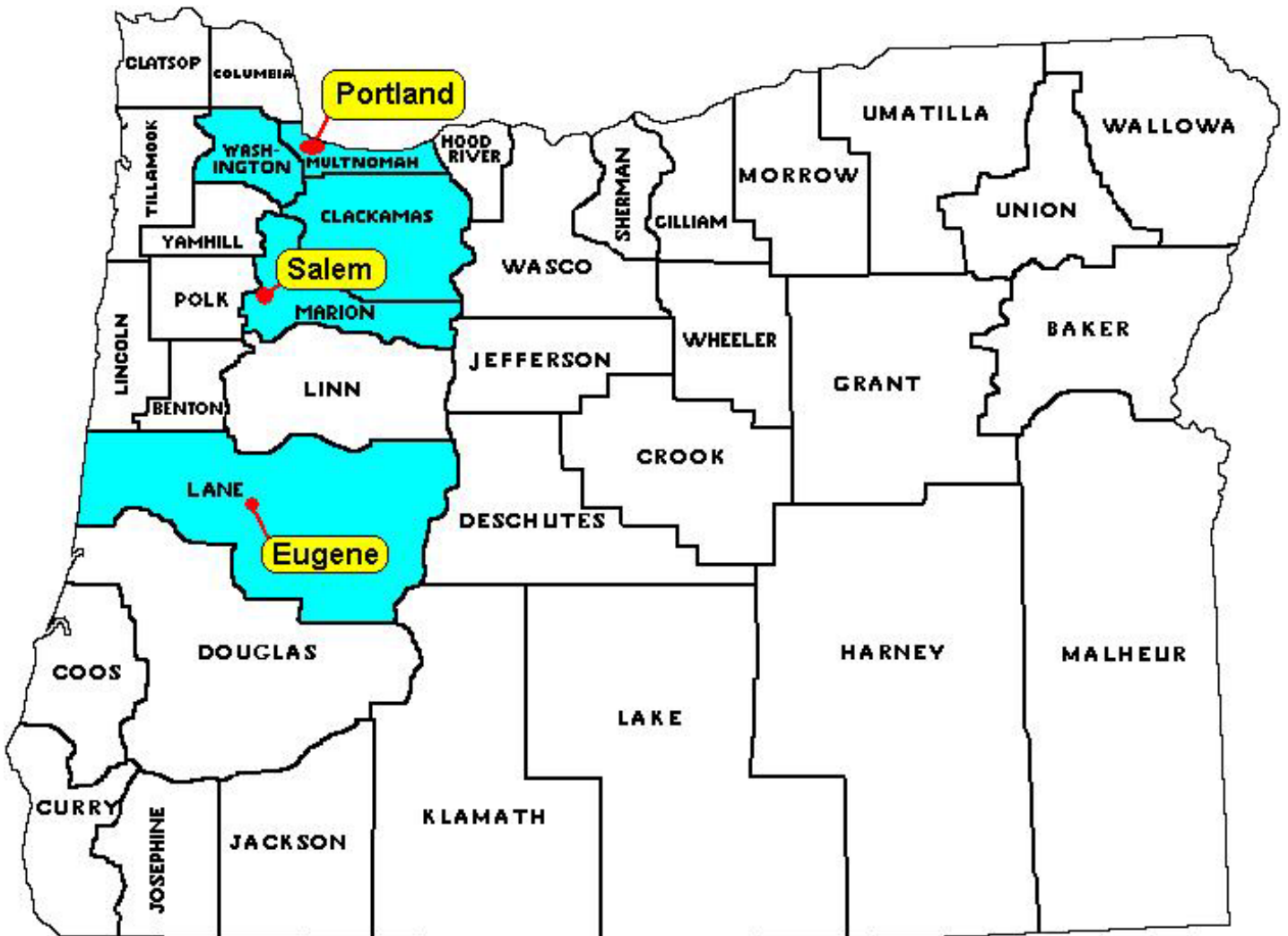
Arrests of Adults (persons 18 years and older) increased 13.0%.

Arrests of Juveniles (persons 17 years and younger) increased 1.5%.

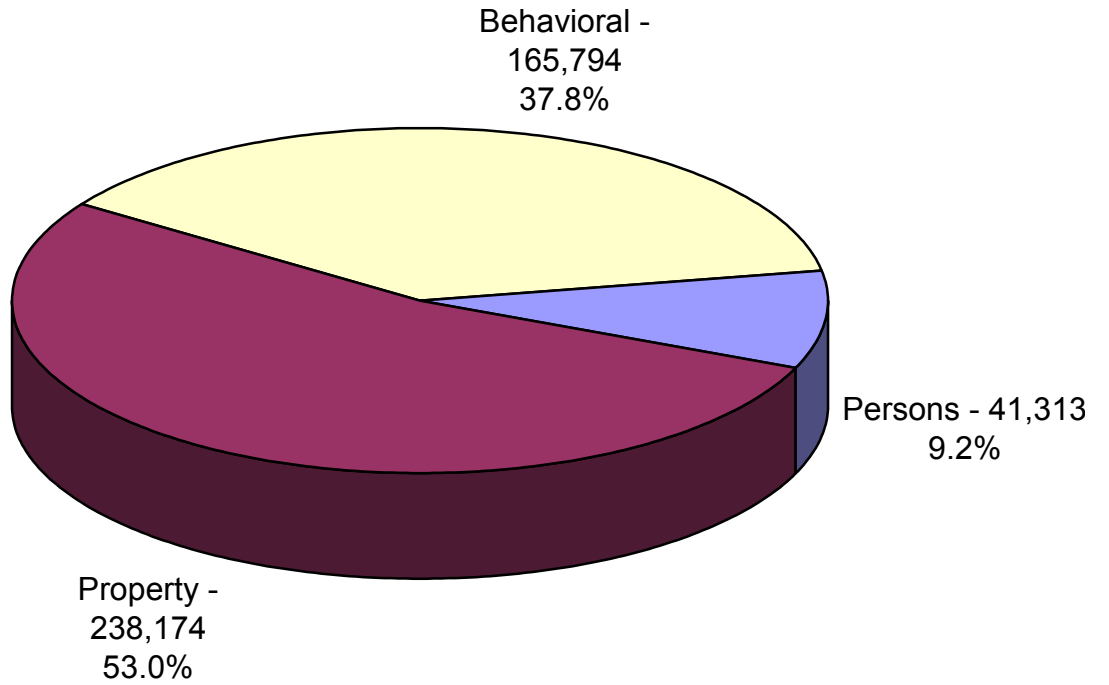
2004 CRIMINAL OFFENSES by POPULATION CENTER

The cities of Portland, Salem and Eugene, combined have 23.4% of the Oregon population and reported 34.2% of the Crimes Against Persons, 33.7% of the Crimes Against Property, 25.3% of Behavioral Crimes and 30.6% of the Crime Total.

Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, Marion and Lane Counties contain 60.1% of the State's population and reported 59.2% of the Crime Total.

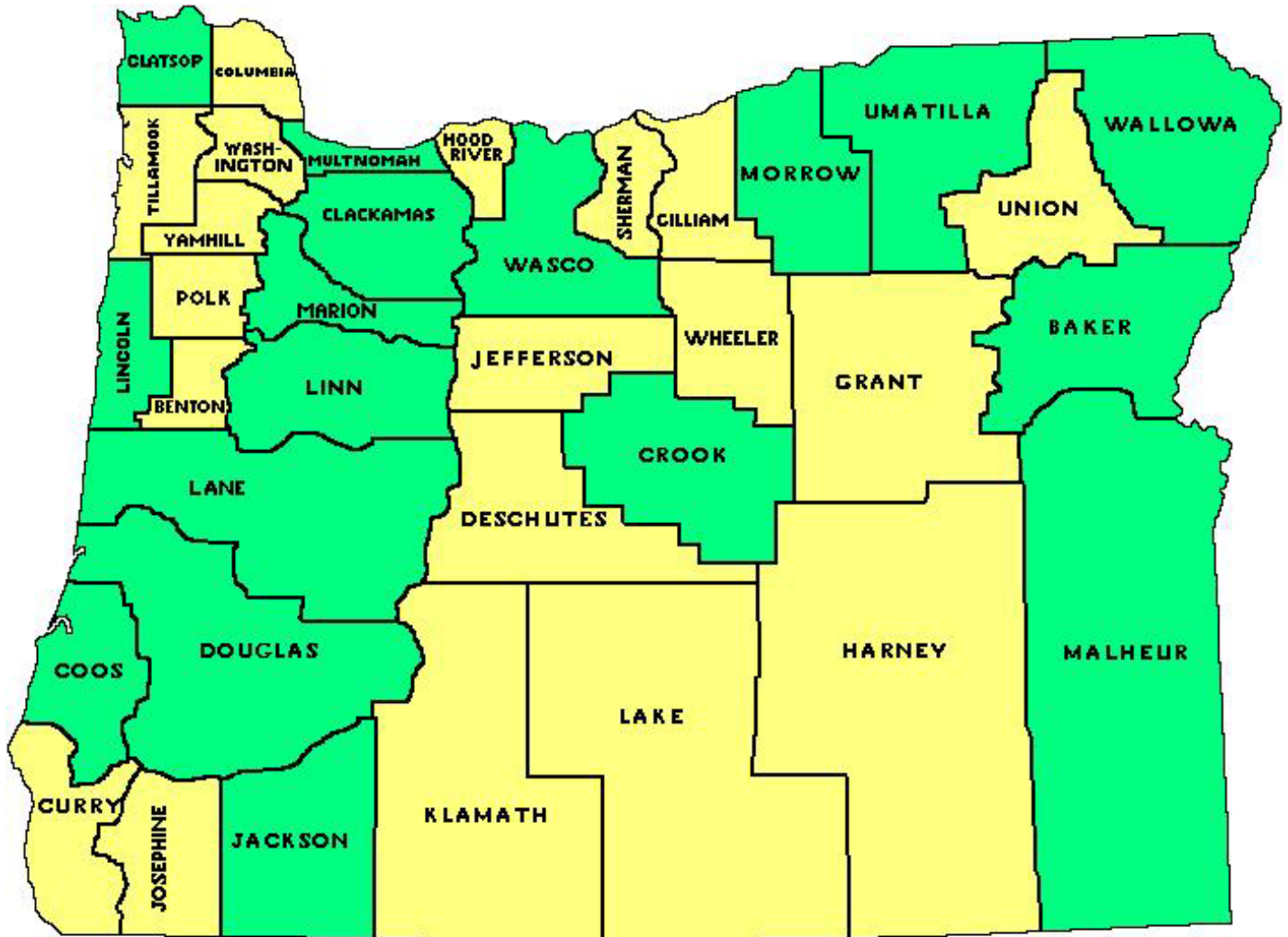

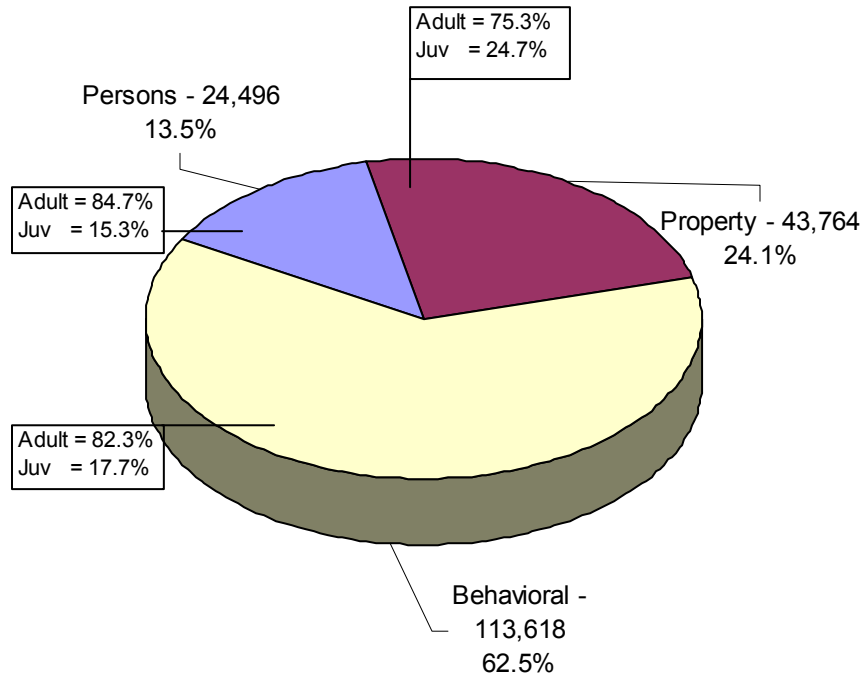

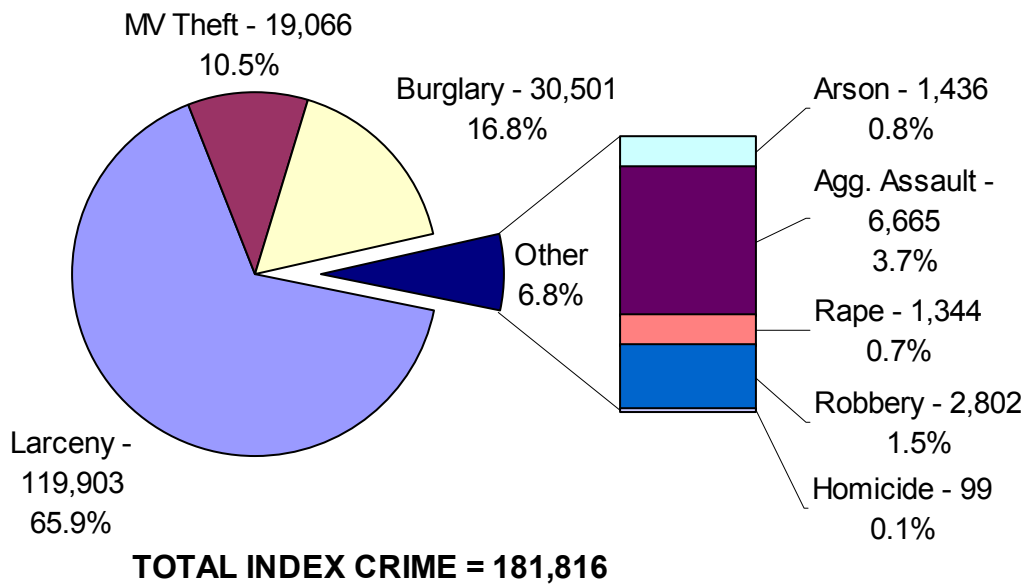

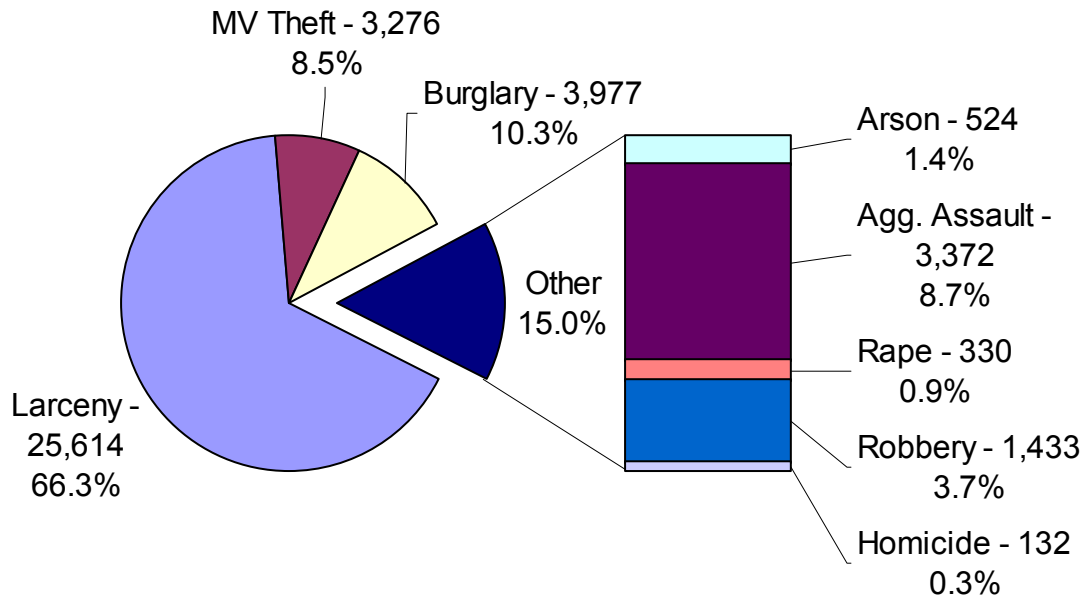
TOTAL REPORTED INDEX CRIME OFFENSES January through December 2004

TOTAL REPORTED INDEX CRIME ARRESTS January through December 2004

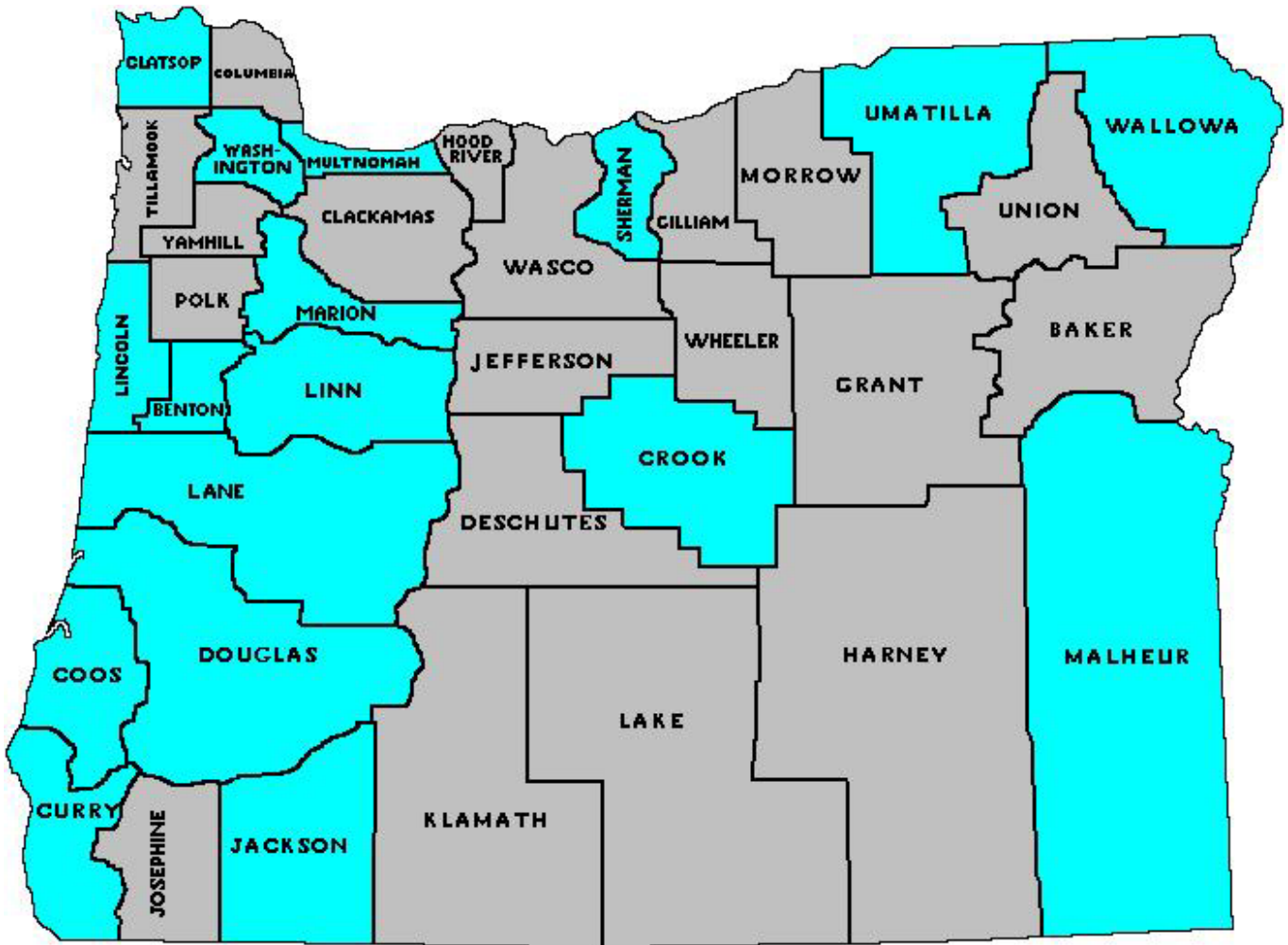


OREGON COUNTY MAP

TEN YEAR CRIME RATES BY CRIME CATEGORY

The chart below represents the rate of crime, by crime category, per 10,000 in population. Crime rates are based on simple averages. For example: in 2004 the rate of Crimes Against Persons (violent crimes) was 115.3 offenses per 10,000 in population. What this means is that for every 10,000 people, there was an average of 115.3 Crimes Against Persons.

A key point to remember is that while the actual number of criminal offenses may increase from one year to the next, generally the population increases, as well. This means that the number of criminal offenses may be higher in 2004 than in 1995, but with the increase in population the actual rate of crime per 10,000 in population can be less.

In the ten years since 1995, the total number of criminal offenses has decreased by 4.7 percent. However, with the increase in population, the rates of crime (by category) have changed as follows: Crimes Against Persons (violent crimes) decreased by 34.2 percent. Crimes Against Property decreased by 22.4 percent. Crimes Against Behavioral Crimes (society crimes) decreased by 0.02 percent. All three crime categories combined decreased by 16.7 percent.

The end result is that the average Oregonian's chance of being a victim of crime was less in 2004 than in 9 of the 10 years since 1995. Only 2002 had a lower rate of crime.
