SPECIAL NOTICE: Due to processing difficulties, officer assault data for several agencies (primarily in Jackson, Marion and Yamhill Counties) is not included in this report. The number of employees is current for 2005.

Pages 7-4 through 7-8 show the numbers of law enforcement employees within each county. Oregon State Police (OSP) and Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) personnel frequently cross county borders in order to perform their duties. Just because no OSP and/or OLCC personnel may be shown for a given county does not mean that there is no presence within the county by either of these 2 agencies. It means that OSP troopers and/or OLCC agents who do work within that county are actually stationed (and therefore counted) within a different county.

## LAW ENFORCEMENT EMPLOYEES - STATEWIDE - 2005

The number of officers is the number of full time Law Enforcement Officers who are certified, certifiable or in process of being certified by the Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training.

The number of support staff includes full time, non-officer staff such as records, communications and clerical employees.
