

**SECTION 1**  
**STATEWIDE SUMMARY**

This section presents an overview of Statewide Statistics relating to criminal Offenses and Arrests for 2005.

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## **SUMMARY**

### **CRIME IN OREGON**

Crime in Oregon decreased 0.1% overall in 2005 when compared to 2004. Crime increased in 13 of the 36 counties in Oregon.

The counties of Clackamas, Lane, Marion, Multnomah and Washington represent 60.1% of the State's population. These 5 counties reported 58.4% of the total crime in Oregon and 62.2% of the total Crimes Against Persons. If these 5 counties are excluded, crime in the rest of the State actually increased overall by 1.9% in 2005.

### **OREGON POPULATION**

Population estimates for Oregon are provided by the Population Research Center, College of Urban and Public Affairs, Portland State University. Total Oregon population for 2005 statistics is 3,631,440. Population in 2004 was 3,582,600. This is an overall increase in population of 1.4%.

### **CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS**

Crimes Against Persons increased 0.3% from 2004 to 2005.

#### **DECREASES REPORTED:**

Willful Murder (-17.2%), Other Sex Offenses, Kidnapping and Robbery.

#### **INCREASES REPORTED:**

Rape, Aggravated Assault and Simple Assault.

Negligent Homicide remained unchanged (13 for both 2004 and 2005).

### **CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY**

Crimes Against Property decreased 1.8% from 2004 to 2005.

#### **DECREASES REPORTED:**

Burglary, Larceny, Arson, Forger/Counterfeiting, Fraud, and Stolen Property (buy, sell, possess)

#### **INCREASES REPORTED:**

Motor Vehicle Theft, Embezzlement and Vandalism.

## **BEHAVIORAL CRIMES**

Behavioral Crimes increased 2.1% from 2004 to 2005.

### **DECREASES REPORTED:**

Weapon Laws, Crimes Against Family, D.U.I.I., Liquor Laws, Disorderly Conduct and Curfew.

### **INCREASES REPORTED:**

Prostitution, Drug Laws, Gambling, "All Other" and Runaway Juveniles.

## **INDEX CRIME RATE**

The Crime Index was developed in the 1920's as a means of measuring crime on a national scale from one year to the next. Because laws define crimes differently between the individual states, 8 specific crimes were chosen to make up the Crime Index rather than including all reported crimes. The 8 crimes that make up the Crime Index are: Willful Murder, Forcible Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny (Theft), Motor Vehicle Theft and Arson. These 8 crimes were selected because they are generally defined the same by each state.

The Index Crime Rate is the "official" measurement of crime used nationally.

Oregon's Index Crime Rate for 2005 was 490.9 crimes per 10,000 population. This is a 3.3% decrease from the rate of 507.5 for 2004. These rates are based on estimated populations of 3,582,500 for 2004 and 3,631,440 for 2005.

## **ARRESTS IN OREGON**

Arrests = 165,960 (This excludes arrests for Traffic Crime, Fish & Game, or Marine)

The total number of arrests decreased 8.8% in 2005.

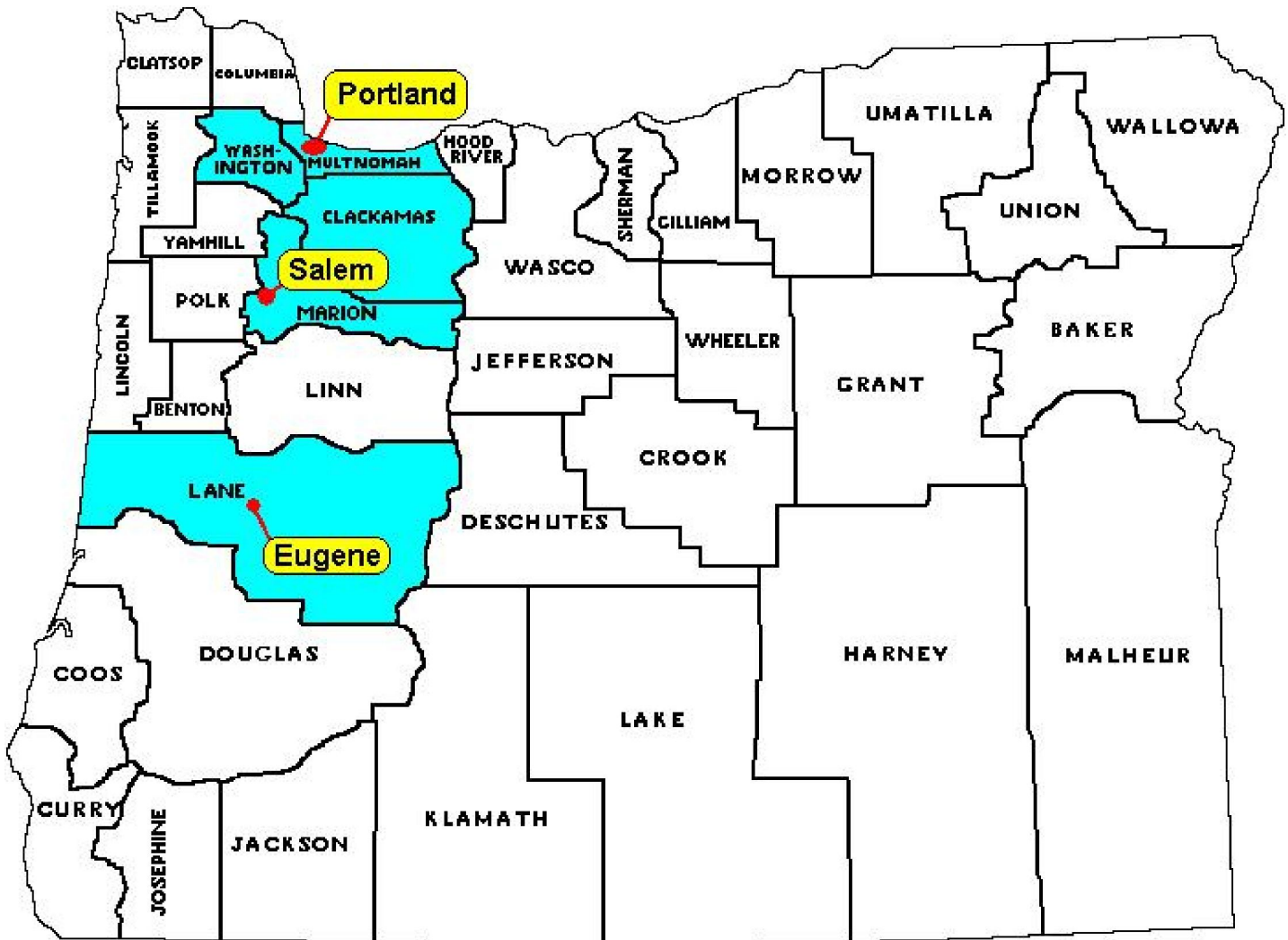
Arrests of Adults (persons 18 years and older) decreased 8.6%.

Arrests of Juveniles (persons 17 years and younger) decreased 9.2%.

## 2005 CRIMINAL OFFENSES by POPULATION CENTER

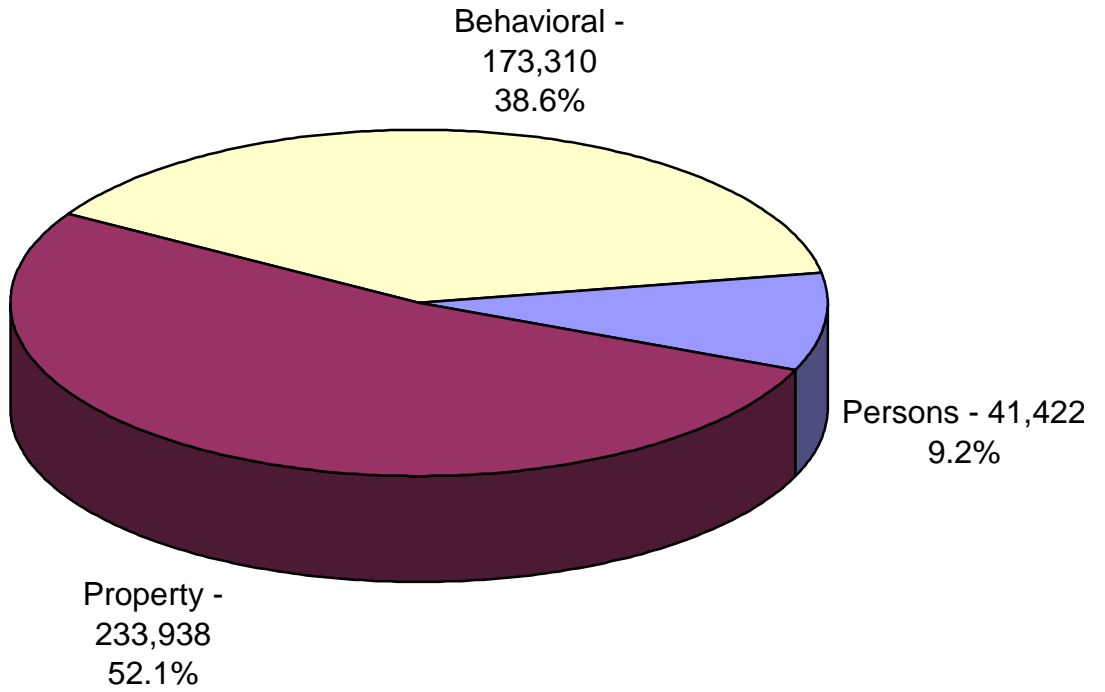
The cities of Portland, Salem and Eugene, combined have 23.4% of the Oregon population and reported 33.8% of the Crimes Against Persons, 32.9% of the Crimes Against Property, 25.0% of Behavioral Crimes and 29.9% of the Crime Total.

Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, Marion and Lane Counties contain 60.1% of the State's population and reported 58.4% of the Crime Total.

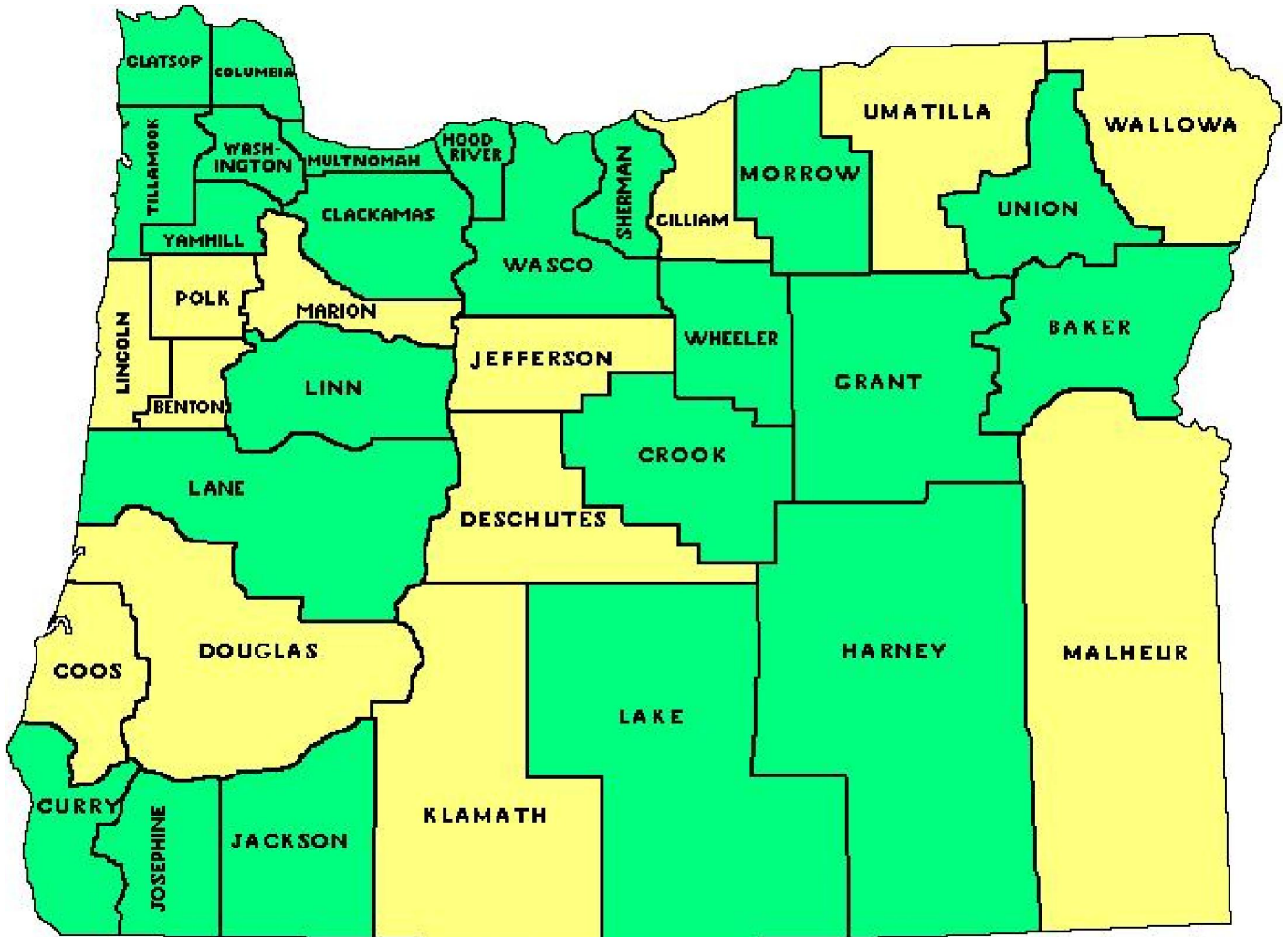

Decrease



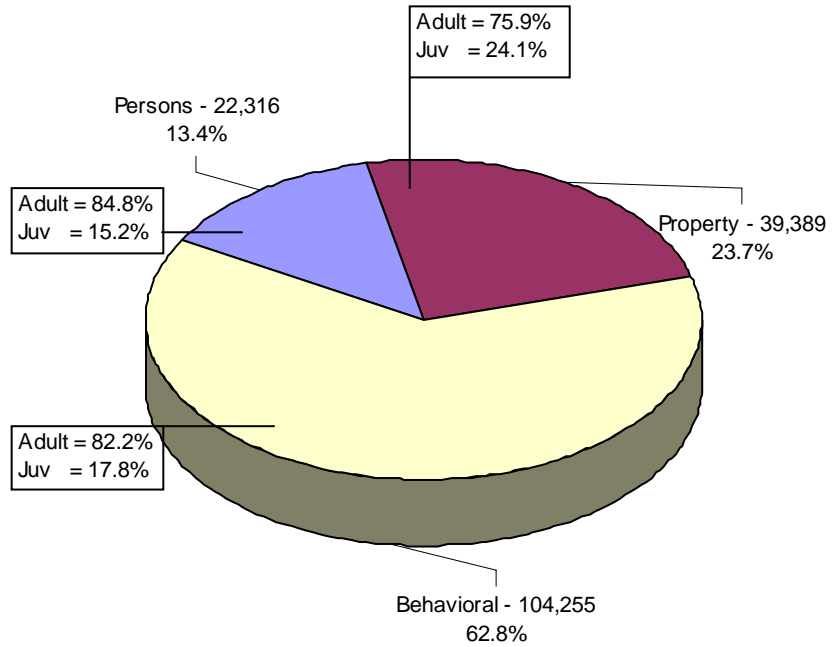

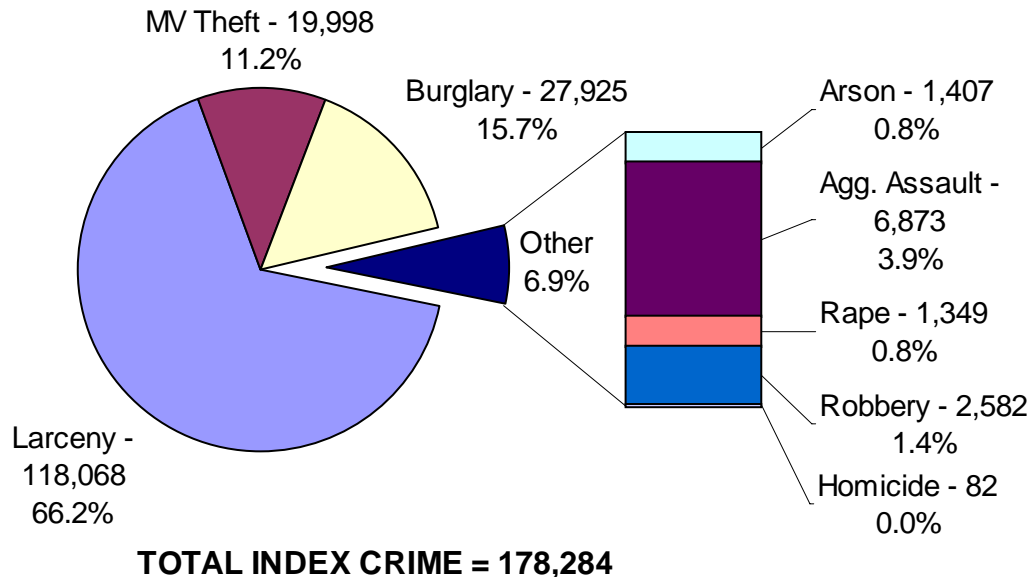

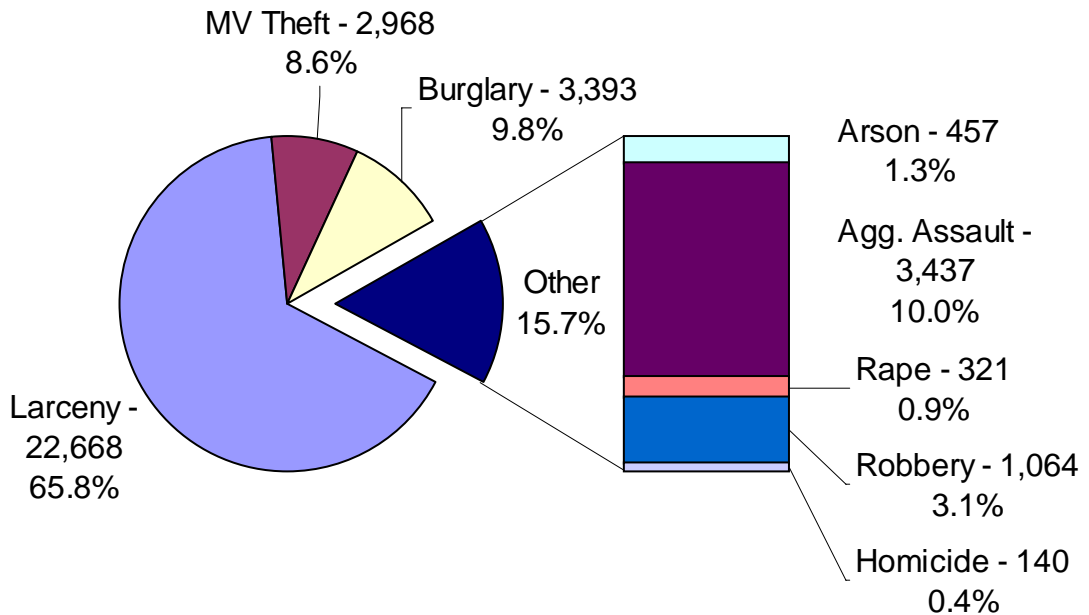
### TOTAL REPORTED INDEX CRIME OFFENSES January through December 2005

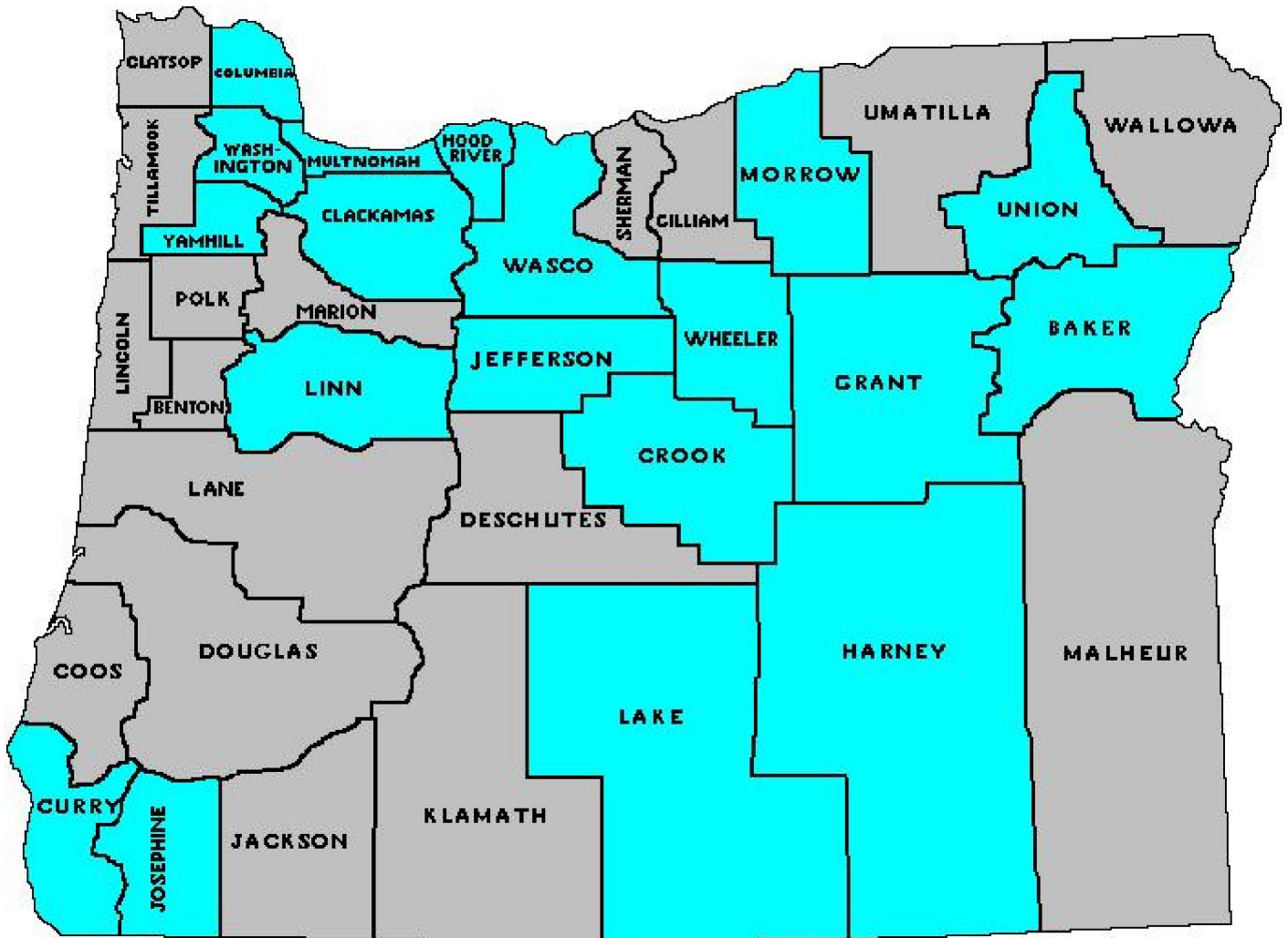

## TEN YEAR CRIME RATES BY CRIME CATEGORY

The chart below represents the rate of crime, by crime category, per 10,000 in population. Crime rates are based on simple averages. For example: in 2005 the rate of Crimes Against Persons (violent crimes) was 114.1 offenses per 10,000 in population. What this means is that for every 10,000 people, there was an average of 114.1 Crimes Against Persons.

A key point to remember is that while the actual number of criminal offenses may increase from one year to the next, generally the population increases, as well. This means that the number of criminal offenses may be higher in 2005 than in 1996, but with the increase in population the actual rate of crime per 10,000 in population can be less.

In the ten years since 1996, the total number of criminal offenses has decreased by 1.6 percent. However, with the increase in population, the rates of crime (by category) have changed as follows: Crimes Against Persons (violent crimes) decreased by 26.5 percent. Crimes Against Property decreased by 18.4 percent. Crimes Against Behavioral Crimes (society crimes) decreased by 3.3 percent. All three crime categories combined decreased by 14.1 percent.

The end result is that the average Oregonian's chance of being a victim of crime was less in 2005 than in any of the 10 years since 1996.
