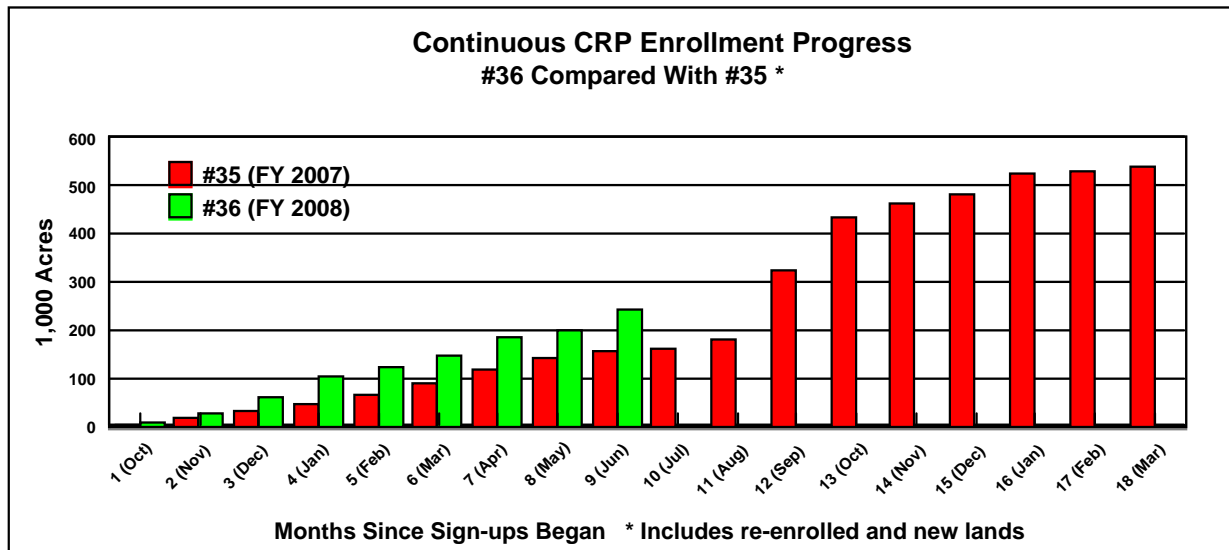

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – June 2008

- Enrollment of land in the State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE) initiative has begun. About 37,000 acres have been approved for enrollment so far, including about 25,000 acres in South Dakota. These acres are not included in some of the tables in this report. Many other acres have been offered, but were not approved and recorded as of June 30, 2008.
- Sign-up 35 (FY 2007 continuous sign-up) ended at 537,000 acres, including new lands and land under re-enrolled 9/30/2007-expired contracts. Sign-up 36 (FY 2008 continuous sign-up) added 43,000 acres in June and now stands at 242,000 acres, 57 percent higher than last year's sign-up through June 2007.
- Land currently under contract for the 2008 crop year, 34.61 million acres, is down 2.16 million acres from last year's 36.77 million acres. States with the largest decline are North Dakota and South Dakota, with declines of 384,000 acres and 264,000 acres, respectively (see page 17).
- Results of 2006's re-enrollment and extension (REX) offer for general sign-up contracts originally set to expire between 2007 and 2010 show contracts on 23.0 million acres, 83 percent, of the 27.8 million eligible acres will be extended or re-enrolled under new contracts. See p.14 for details.
- The new contract expiration schedule is provided (pages 15 and 16). It shows that 2.5 million acres expired September 30, 2007, some of which have been re-enrolled as continuous sign-up practices.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips and riparian buffers, at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 41 agreements in 31 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through June 30, 2008, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files.

Note: Contracts re-enrolled under 2006's re-enrollment and extension offer (REX) are not considered to expire when the current contracts expire, because new contracts will begin immediately after expiration.
