Expected Outcomes

- It takes <u>commitment</u>, <u>accountability</u> and <u>time</u> for implementation to succeed
- Long-term (~50+ years)
 - Landscape strategies
 - Forest lands
 - Incremental improvements riparian/WQ/instream conditions
 - Benefits really don't appear for 60+ years
 - Rate and magnitude varies by ownership
 - Agricultural lands
 - Incremental improvements in WQ, limited habitat benefits?
 - Targeted Restoration
 - Creating HQ habitat for coho (and other sp.)

Expected Outcomes (cont'd)

- Short-term (now ~ 50+ years)
 - Harvest management supports recovery
 - Hatchery management
 - Salmon and N. Umpqua populations viable
 - Existing hatchery programs support recovery
 - Habitat
 - Maintain existing land management protections
 - Targeted restoration
 - Increasing HQ habitat
 - Restore watershed processes to improve coho habitat
