DIRECTIONS TO MEETING SITE:

Hwy 101 from the south:

At the center of Newport, there is a major four-way intersection of Hwy 101 & Hwy 20 (there will be a Bank of America on the left and a Power Dodge dealership on the right), turn right onto Hwy 20 heading east. At the first stop light (approximately 8 blocks), take a right on John Moore Rd. Follow John Moore to the bottom of the hill and veer to the left onto Bay Blvd. The entrance to the Embarcadero is the first driveway on the right. 1000 S.E. Bay Blvd.

Hwy 101 from the north:

At the center of Newport, there is a major four-way intersection of Hwy 101 & Hwy 20, (there will be a Thriftway on the right and a Shell station on the left, turn left onto Hwy 20 heading East. At the first stop light (approximately 8 blocks), take a right on John Moore Rd. Follow John Moore to the bottom of the hill and veer to the left onto Bay Blvd. The entrance to the Embarcadero is the first driveway on the right. 1000 S.E. Bay Blvd.
