



- Test drive NFCP and HMP
- Evaluate OP effectiveness for coastal coho
- Inform listing determination PECE Policy
- Inform & expedite Conservation/Recovery Plan
- Secure legal assurances for local participants

Key Principles

- Recovery actions most *effective* if based on sound science addressing key limiting factors
- Recovery actions most *supported* if developed and implemented collaboratively
- Participation most secure if linked to legal assurances recognizing the contribution and protecting the participant
- Recovery plans most likely completed, implemented and successful if based on adaptive management



Oregon Plan Coastal Coho Assessment

- Why do an assessment?
 - Adaptive management requires periodic evaluation of efforts
 - Coastal coho: catalyst for OP, rich data set, aid recovery planning
 - Help improve implementation of Oregon Plan
 - Help prioritize funding
 - Make the most of concurrent federal actions

Oregon Plan Coastal Coho Assessment

- Governor's Office oversight
- Significant State effort 15 teams and all OP partners participating
- Two major categories of assessments:
 - Fish Management (harvest, hatcheries, hydro, predator, exotic species, fish health)
 - Habitat
- Link to State/Federal science products: Are Oregon Plan activities addressing primary bottlenecks? What is the future outlook?
- Identify additional activities and commitments, if necessary.

NOAA Fisheries' Status Review & Listing Determination

- Status Review of 27 ESUs, including Oregon Coastal Coho ESU
- FR notice of proposed listing determination June 2004
- Policy for Evaluating Conservation Efforts
- Submit OP Coastal Coho Assessment to inform NOAA's listing decision (as per PECE policy)

- Existing status
- Causes for gap
- Management actions
- Monitoring and evaluation
















- Proposed Listing determination: June '04
