Lamantia waives the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 52 and Internal Revenue Code (I.R.C.) (26 U.S.C.) §§ 7402(a) and 7408.

Lamantia consents to entry of this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction without admitting that grounds exist for imposition of an injunction.

Lamantia enters into this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction voluntarily and waives any right he may have to appeal from it.

Lamantia consents to entry of this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction without further notice and agrees that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over him for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

The Court accordingly ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES that:

- 1. The Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1340 and 1345 and I.R.C. §§ 7402(a) and 7408.
- 2. The Court finds that the multi-level marketing scheme and other tax schemes sold by Global Prosperity vendors and Lamantia violated various provisions of the Internal Revenue Code.
 - 3. The Court finds that Lamantia consents to the entry of this injunction.
- 4. It is further ORDERED that Lamantia, individually and doing business under any other name or using any other entity, and his representatives, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and those persons in active concert or participation with him, is permanently enjoined and restrained from, directly or indirectly:
