TO: All Warehouse Operators approved for Dry, Cooler & or Freezer Storage

under the Processed Commodities Storage Agreement, (PCSA)

SUBJECT: Certification of Storage Invoices

This is a reminder that it is the responsibility of a facility's certifying representative to review all the invoice information thoroughly. Incorrect rates or other computations in error on the invoice must be identified by the certifying representative by disputing the invoice and identifying the error (i.e. incorrect rates).

The invoice certification statement explicitly declares this as follows:

"The amount above shown is due and owing to the warehouse operator and I hereby claim payment. I hereby certify that **this invoice has been verified in detail by me** or by someone under my direction, which verification has included the careful examination of inventories and storage obligations...."

If rates or other storage details are incorrect and invoices <u>are disputed</u>, invoices can be easily system adjusted to pay the correct amount due and owing to the warehouse. When errors are not identified by the certifying representative, and the invoice is paid, a time-consuming manual process is required to correct the erroneous payment.
