Sources: With the exception of net realized capital gains, all data used to generate the TTR estimates come from the Bureau of Economic Analysis. The most recent Gross State Product data series was released in June 7, 1999 and the State Personal Income series was released September 14, 1998. Several unpublished estimates from both data series were used to estimate TTR. The estimates for net realized capital gains are from the Internal Revenue Service, Statistics of Income Bulletin, Spring issues 1996-1999.
