

# INTOXILYZER 8000 OPERATOR'S TRAINING

Intoxilyzer 8000 Operator's Conversion Training is beginning on July 20, 2006.

**THIS TRAINING IS MANDATORY TO OBTAIN A PERMIT TO OPERATE THE INTOXILYZER 8000. REPLACEMENT OF INTOXILYZER 5000 INSTRUMENTATION IS BEGINNING IMMEDIATELY. OFFICERS WILL ONLY HAVE ACCESS TO INTOXILYZER 8000 INSTRUMENTATION ONCE INTOXILYZER 5000 EQUIPMENT HAS BEEN REMOVED.**

Marion County has been selected as the initial training and installation venue and class schedules for all "Region I" operators in Benton, Clackamas, Clatsop, Columbia, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Tillamook, Washington, and Yamhill Counties are currently being set.
