UPDATE FOR WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 15 TO SEPTEMBER 21, 2008

Work this week includes crushing rock and hauling gravel in the Lulu quarry, pipe culvert installation and dirt work. From the Yellowstone National Park (YNP) Northeast Entrance through Cooke City, motorists can expect the existing asphalt or rough gravel surfaces. Motorcycles should use extreme caution. Motorists should be aware of workers and equipment along the highway and Lulu Pass Road. Heavy truck traffic is anticipated from Lulu Pass Road through Silver Gate. Please expect the following delays:

US 212 east of YNP NE Entrance to Cooke City

Possible 30-minute delays beginning at 6 a.m. Monday 9/15 and ending at 6 p.m. Friday 9/19
