Example of Technology	Need That Is Being Addressed	Benefits	Unintended Consequences
Windmills	Lack of access to water for irrigation	<p>Crops have access to water.</p> <p>Wind power is a renewable resource that is free (except for maintenance) in this community.</p> <p>The windmills in the community are seen as aesthetically pleasing and have actually brought some small scale tourism to the community.</p>	<p>The maintenance of the windmills can be expensive. Although most of the parts are locally made, there are a few, such as the pistons and the metal tubes that draw the water, that must be maintained or purchased outside the village.</p> <p>Some hard labor is required to keep them running. For example, they need to be primed to get them started.</p>
Information Technology (computers, Internet, blogging)	<p>Lack of access to acquiring skills in information technology</p> <p>An unaffordable means of communication</p> <p>Limited accessibility to reach a large audience</p>	<p>Acquired skills can make the individual more marketable for employment.</p> <p>Allows for better management of household and business related finances</p> <p>There are more opportunities to communicate with friends and family in an inexpensive way; the Internet and blogging allow an individual to post pictures and write a long letter for the same price as a short phone call.</p> <p>Increased learning and income-generating opportunities (e.g., beekeeping project)</p> <p>Ability to communicate and voice one's opinions to the global community</p> <p>Opportunity for profound discussions covering various issues</p>	<p>Viruses and spyware caused a number problems to the operating systems; some computers crashed because there was no antivirus software.</p> <p>Some adults and students were found using inappropriate websites, which resulted in more patrolling and ultimately the purchase of software that would block inappropriate sites.</p> <p>There was a problem with individuals sharing each other's passwords and accounts; friends were checking each other's accounts and sending e-mails from them.</p> <p>Some businesses set up accounts to reach a larger audience, but didn't follow through with checking them, which resulted in numerous missed opportunities</p>
