Source of the Information

Workforce development partners submit service-delivery information on customers to Oregon's Performance Reporting Information System (PRISM). Those customers' records are matched with Unemployment Insurance wage records to determine whether they found jobs, whether the remained employed, and how their wages fared over a period of a year.
