Arrests, of Persons Under 15, 18, 21, and 25 Years of Age, 2007

- Nationwide in 2007, persons under the age of 25 accounted for 44.4 percent of all arrestees.
- Individuals under the age of 25 comprised 45.3 percent of all arrests for violent crime and 54.6 percent of all arrests for property crime.
- Persons under the age of 25 accounted for 50.4 percent of those arrested for murder and 64.7 percent of those arrested for robbery.
- Of all persons arrested for arson in 2007, 28.0 percent were under the age of 15; this was the highest percent distribution for this age group among all offense categories.
