Current Year Over Previous Year Arrest Trends, Totals, 2006-2007

- In 2007, the total number of persons arrested decreased less than 1 percent (0.3) from the number arrested in 2006.
- For violent crimes, the number of persons arrested decreased 1.1 percent from 2006 to 2007.
- The 2-year trend showed the number of juveniles (persons under age 18) arrested in 2007 decreased 1.6 percent from the number arrested the previous year.
- The number of juveniles arrested for violent crimes decreased 2.8 percent during the 2-year period.
- The number of persons arrested for murder and nonnegligent manslaughter declined 0.1 percent. The number of juveniles arrested for this offense rose 2.8 percent.
- For property crimes, the number of adults arrested in 2007 increased 5.9 percent from the number arrested in 2006; the number of juveniles arrested increased 3.9 percent.
