Arrests, City, by Sex, 2007

- Of the 8,166,688 persons arrested in the Nation's cities during 2007, males accounted for 75.5 percent of the arrestees.
- Males comprised 81.5 percent of persons arrested for violent crime and
 65.3 percent of those arrested for property crime.
- In the Nation's cities, males were most frequently arrested for drug abuse violations (875,418) and other (simple) assaults (561,610).
- Females were most often arrested for larceny-theft offenses (311,897) and for drug abuse violations (198,472).
