EMPLOYMENT RELATED Day Care Program

Help for working parents. Things have changed!





You may now be able to get help paying for child care while you work!

There have been changes to the Employment Related Day Care (ERDC) program. Because of the changes, you may now qualify for the program.

- For example:
 - » A family of 2 can have income up to \$2,159 and still be able to get help.
 - » A family of 3 can have income up to \$2,714 and still be able to get help.
- Copay amounts have gone down and the amounts paid to child care providers have gone up.
 - » This means the part you pay for child care could be less than in the past.
