**RULE SUMMARY**

The Motor Carrier Transportation Division of the Oregon Department of Transportation previously issued a Waiver of Physical Disqualification which allows intrastate operation of commercial motor vehicles by a commercial driver license holder who is determined to be medically qualified under Oregon criteria. The responsibility for issuing these waivers was transferred to the Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division of ODOT on October 1, 2007. These rule amendments were made in order to reflect the change.
