RULE CAPTION

Establishes Eligibility Requirements and Procedures for the Issuance of Veterans' Recognition Registration Plates

RULE SUMMARY

ORS 805.105 requires DMV to establish: (1) General qualifications for veterans' groups that wish to become eligible for veterans' recognition registration plates; (2) When DMV may cease to issue veterans' recognition registration plates; (3) What constitutes proof of veteran status for the issuance of veterans' recognition registration plates, and (4) What constitutes proof that a person is a surviving family member of a person killed in action during an armed conflict while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States in order to qualify for special veterans' recognition registration plates that include a gold star decal and the words "Gold Star Family." DMV amended its special group registration plate rules to conform to the law changes.
