RULE SUMMARY

These amendments implement legislation enacted by the 2007 Legislative Assembly which directs DMV to issue custom registration plates to motor vehicle owners who are qualified Congressional Medal of Honor recipients. These rules define terms and describe the procedures and requirements for the issuance of custom, or special, registration plates—sometimes referred to as personalized license plates, add new provisions, and reorganize and clarify the definitions set out in the rule. Other changes were made for clarity and readability.
