ODOT has amended the timelines for the Relocation Appeal Process to make them less restrictive and allow a reasonable amount of time for pre-hearing conferences and contested case hearings, and investigations which could possibly resolve the issues without going to the formal hearing process. The relaxed timelines are allowed in the statutory process for contested case hearings.
