RULE SUMMARY

SB 1084 of the 2008 special session grants an exception to a pedestrian committing the offense of pedestrian with improper position upon a highway if the pedestrian does not impede traffic or create a traffic hazard, posts advance warning signs, wears high-visibility safety apparel in compliance with standards adopted by the Oregon Transportation Commission, and obtains a permit from the appropriate road authority. These rules describe how a pedestrian would obtain a permit from the Department of Transportation for activities along a state highway.
