

## Appendix 6: Land Ownership (from Wires et al. 2001)

Alabama	Ownership reported for 11 (out of 16) roosting/feeding sites: 6 ACOE <sup>1</sup> , 5 private
Arkansas	Of 9 sites, 3 ACOE, 2 State, and 4 private
California	Coastal colonies owned by NPS <sup>2</sup> , BLM <sup>3</sup> , USFWS, Tolowa Tribe, and others; Salton Sea colony owned by USFWS; colonies in the San Francisco Bay area managed by various state and federal agencies; others unknown
Georgia	Wintering sites along lower Atlanta River and delta are on State, Federal, and private lands; along coast, mostly State and Federal land
Idaho	Sites mostly public; BREC <sup>n</sup> , BIA*, USFWS and State
Illinois	Sites public; ACOE and unknown
Indiana	One major stopover site reported as State-owned
Iowa	All colonies are on Federal land
Kansas	Ownership reported for 4 (out of 6) colonies: State, ACOE, and BREC; large numbers of migrants occur mostly on ACOE and BREC reservoirs
Kentucky	Of 2 roosting/feeding sites, one ACOE and one private
Maine	Of 17 colonies, 12 private, 3 State, one USFWS, and one owned by a municipality
Maryland	Of 4 colonies, 3 on State land and one on USFWS
Massachusetts	Ownership reported for 9 (out of 28) colonies: 6 public, 3 private
Michigan	Ownership reported for 14 (out of 51) colonies: 3 private, 11 Federal
Minnesota	2 of 3 Great Lakes colonies are on BLM land (Lake Superior); most MN colonies occur inland and ownership not reported
Mississippi	2 colonies on private land; 19 of 76 winter roost sites are on public land, 57 private
Missouri	Of 5 major stopover sites, 4 on ACOE or USFWS land and one on State land
Nebraska	2 colonies on USFWS land
New Hampshire	Of 3 colonies, 2 private and one State
New York	Coastal: of 5 colonies, 3 private and 2 State; Inland: of 12 colonies, 7 private and 5 Federal or State
North Carolina	One colony on private land and one on USFS** land; coastal wintering areas primarily Federal and State-owned
Ohio	2 colonies; one USFWS and one State

Oklahoma	2 colonies, both on USFWS land
Pennsylvania	Ownership reported for 3 sites: 2 State and one ACOE
Rhode Island	Of 12 colonies, 10 private and 2 State
Utah	Of 8 colonies, one USFWS and others unknown
Vermont	Of 5 sites, 2 State, 2 private, one Federal
Wyoming	Of 25 colonies, 9 public, 11 private, and 5 unknown
