VONPDF

PURPOSE

Compute the Von Mises probability density function with shape parameter κ .

DESCRIPTION

The standard form of the Von Mises probability density function is:

$$f(x) = \frac{e^{\kappa \cos(x)}}{2\pi I_0(\kappa)} - \pi \le x \le \pi$$
 (EQ 8-350)

where κ is the shape parameter and I_0 is the modified Bessel function of order zero. The Von Mises distribution is a circular function with a period of 2π . If the input argument is outside the interval $(-\pi,\pi)$, DATAPLOT converts it to the equivalent argument in that interval

A shape parameter of 0 reduces to a rectangular distribution on the $(-\pi,\pi)$ interval. The Von Mises distribution approaches a normal distribution as κ gets large.

SYNTAX

LET <y2> = VONPDF(<y1>,) <SUBSET/EXCEPT/FOR qualification>

where <y1> is a variable, number, or parameter containing values in the interval (-PI,PI);

 is a non-negative number, parameter, or variable;

<y2> is a variable or a parameter (depending on what <x> and are) where the computed pdf value is stored; and where the <SUBSET/EXCEPT/FOR qualification> is optional.

EXAMPLES

LET A = VONPDF(0.5,0)LET Y = VONPDF(X1,4)

NOTE 1

For values of κ less than the logarithm of the largest double precision number (this is approximately 700 for 32 bit machines), the Von Mises probability is calculated from the definition. The DBESI0 routine from the SLATEC library is used to calculate the modified Bessel function. For κ values larger than this, a normal approximation with a standard deviation of SQRT(κ -0.5) is used (see the Mardia paper listed in the REFERENCE section below).

NOTE 2

The general form of the Von Mises probability density function is:

$$f(x) = \frac{e^{\kappa \cos(x-\mu)}}{2\pi I_0(\kappa)} - \pi \le x \le \pi$$
 (EQ 8-351)

where μ is a location parameter. See topic (3) under the General considerations section at the beginning of this chapter for a discussion of generating pdf values for the general form of the distribution. As κ approaches infinity, the density concentrates to a single point (the location parameter μ). The mean is μ and the standard deviation is sqrt(1-I₁(κ)/I₀(κ)) where I₀ and I₁ are the modified Bessel functions of order 0 and 1 respectively.
