The Environmental Management Programs (EMP) office serves as a single-point interface between ORNL and the various EMP sponsors in Oak Ridge and at DOE Headquarters.

EMP's services include

- Interfacing with Bechtel Jacobs Company, LLC (BJC), on the work scope being performed by ORNL staff, and with senior ORNL management on EM-related issues at the ORNL site
- Maintaining a positive working relationship with BJC for waste management, collection, treatment, and disposal and acting as primary stakeholder and ESH&Q oversight of the multiyear remediation operations under way at the ORNL site
- Serving as programmatic lead for establishing and implementing the ORNL waste certification policies



EMP is strictly a program office (manager and secretary) with no direct line responsibilities within the ORNL organizational structure.
