Environmental Protection (EP) provides a wide range of services that facilitate UT-Battelle compliance with federal and state environmental regulations, U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) orders contained in the UT-Battelle Work Smart Standards, and agreements between DOE and/or UT-Battelle and the regulators.

EP services include

- Regulatory review, policy/guidance preparation and dissemination, and technical assistance
- Environmental compliance representatives to line organizations as part of the purchased service model
- Permit and report preparation
- Assisting line organizations in self-assessment
- Assisting regulatory negotiation
- Sampling a wide variety of media and waste forms and can assist with development of sampling plans, statistical analyses, and reporting based on analytical results
- Maintaining relationships with DOE; Bechtel Jacobs Company, LLC (BJC); the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation; and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency
