

167,902 acres in 2002, 163,984 acres in 1997, up 2 percent.

Average size of farm

141 acres in 2002, 135 acres in 1997, up 4 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$41,286,000 in 2002, \$36,017,000 in 1997, up 15 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$6,217,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$35,070,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$34,665 in 2002, \$29,717 in 1997, up 17 percent.


Government Payments
