

# Boyle, Kentucky

#### **Number of farms**

715 farms in 2002, 750 farms in 1997, down 5 percent.

#### Land in farms

98,617 acres in 2002, 98,822 acres in 1997, down slightly.

#### Average size of farm

138 acres in 2002, 132 acres in 1997, up 5 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$22,498,000 in 2002, \$27,661,000 in 1997, down 19 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$4,427,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$18,071,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm




#### **Government Payments**
