Rowan, Kentucky

Number of farms 436 farms in 2002, 459 farms in 1997, down 5 percent.

Land in farms 50,825 acres in 2002, 45,409 acres in 1997, up 12 percent.

Average size of farm 117 acres in 2002, 99 acres in 1997, up 18 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$5,639,000 in 2002, \$4,520,000 in 1997, up 25 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$2,449,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$3,190,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm




