

Bracken, Kentucky

Number of farms

639 farms in 2002, 701 farms in 1997, down 9 percent.

Land in farms

94,393 acres in 2002, 94,588 acres in 1997, down slightly.

Average size of farm

148 acres in 2002, 135 acres in 1997, up 10 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$10,357,000 in 2002, \$17,543,000 in 1997, down 41 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$6,008,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$4,349,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$16,208 in 2002, \$25,026 in 1997, down 35 percent.


Government Payments
