### **Market Value of Production**

\$34,334,000 in 2002, \$36,147,000 in 1997, down 5 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$15,357,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$18,977,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm




