Market Value of Production

\$33,949,000 in 2002, \$36,879,000 in 1997, down 8 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$8,911,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$25,038,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm




