


# **2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile**



## **Grant, Kentucky**

#### **Number of farms**

1,020 farms in 2002, 1,048 farms in 1997, down 3 percent.

#### Land in farms

116,454 acres in 2002, 122,390 acres in 1997, down 5 percent.

#### Average size of farm

114 acres in 2002, 117 acres in 1997, down 3 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$13,199,000 in 2002, \$15,970,000 in 1997, down 17 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$5,518,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$7,680,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$12,940 in 2002, \$15,238 in 1997, down 15 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
