

Market Value of Production

\$574,000 in 2002, \$598,000 in 1997, down 4 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$234,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$339,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm




