

# Powell, Kentucky

#### **Number of farms**

239 farms in 2002, 258 farms in 1997, down 7 percent.

#### Land in farms

37,516 acres in 2002, 30,584 acres in 1997, up 23 percent.

### Average size of farm

157 acres in 2002, 119 acres in 1997, up 32 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$2,484,000 in 2002, \$2,633,000 in 1997, down 6 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$1,470,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$1,014,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm




#### **Government Payments**
