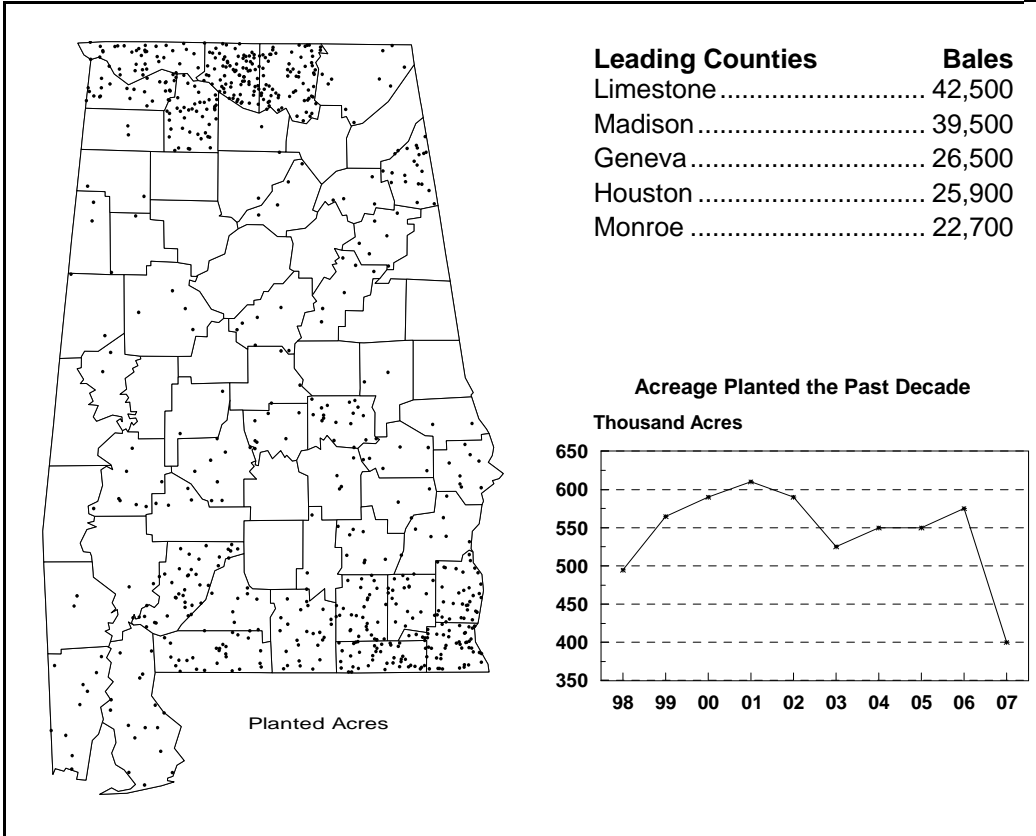

Cotton Acreage And Production, 2007

Limestone County topped all other Alabama counties in cotton production for 2007 with 42,500 bales. The 41,500 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 492 pounds per acre. Other top producing counties for the year were: Madison, Geneva, Houston and Monroe.

Alabama cotton producers harvested a total of 385,000 acres in 2007, down 175,000 acres from the previous year. Yield per acre was 519 pounds of lint. Production totaled 416,000 bales and was valued at \$95.4 million.

Alabama ranked 11th in the United States in cotton production. Texas, Arkansas, Georgia, California and Mississippi, were five leading states.
