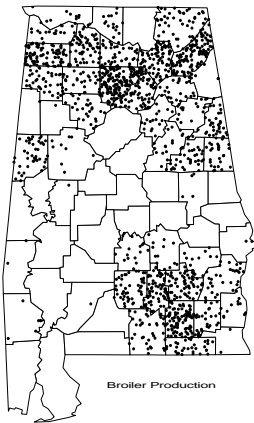
Broiler Production, 2007

During the 2007 marketing year, Alabama broiler growers produced 1.015 billion broilers, down 4 percent from the previous marketing year. Alabama is ranked third in production behind Georgia and Arkansas. Cullman county was the leading producer, followed by DeKalb, Coffee and Franklin. Cash receipts amounted to \$2.40 billion, up 17 percent from the previous year.

Egg Production, 2007

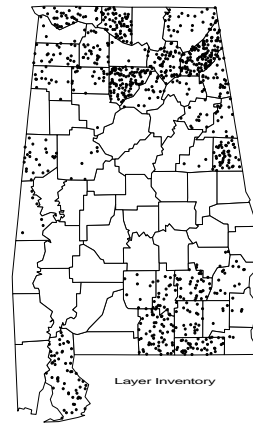
Egg production was 2.1 million, down 2 percent from previous year. Cash receipts totaled \$314.3 million, up 6 percent from the previous year. Nationally, Alabama ranked 14th in egg production. There were 9.4 million layers 20 weeks old and older on hand December 1, 2007, compared with 9.6 million a year earlier. DeKalb county had the largest inventory, followed by Cullman, Limestone and Covington counties.
