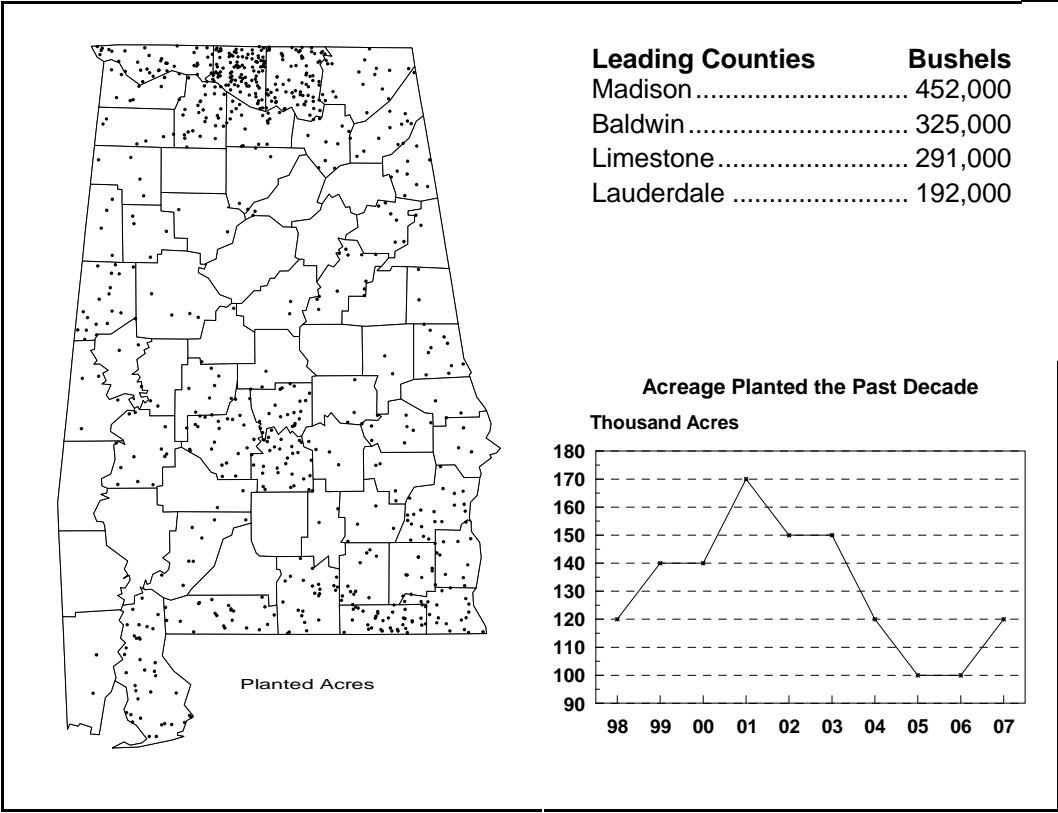

## Wheat Acreage And Production, 2007



Leading Counties	Bushels

Madison county topped all other Alabama counties in wheat production for 2007 with 452,000 bushels. The 10,900 acres harvested by the county's producers averaged 41 bushels per acre. This was 2 bushels below the state average.

Other top producing counties for the year were: Baldwin, Limestone, and Lauderdale.

Alabama wheat producers harvested a total of 80,000 acres in 2007. Yield per acre was 43 bushels. Production totaled 3.4 million bushels and was valued at \$17.7 million.

Alabama ranked 37th in the United States in all wheat production. North Dakota, Kansas, Montana, South Dakota, and Texas were the leading states.
