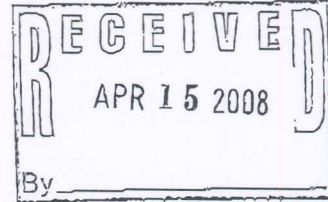

I am the acting President of the Arapahoe County Citizens for Organized, Responsible Development (ACCORD). We represent about 40,000 unincorporated residents throughout the County. At our April 7 meeting, we voted to support the recommendations of the Part 150 Study for Centennial Airport. We believe that the airport has thoroughly researched the impacts of the studies, has received input from all stakeholders and that the recommendations represent the best interests of the citizens of Arapahoe County.

Of particular importance to many of our residents is the adoption of the 010 departure and the "fan departure." These measures will dramatically reduce noise for thousands of residents north and northwest of the airport. We are confident that when teamed with the Fly Quiet Program and the radar-linked noise monitoring system, the interest of the public will be served.
