

As a mother of 2 young children that are frequently woken up or scared by departing Centennial Airport aircraft, I wanted to comment and support the 12 approved recommendations submitted by Centennial Airport in its Part 150 study. I support the airport and its mission, but appreciate your efforts to minimize noise to the surrounding community.

As you know, Centennial Airport has aircraft of all types and being a resident in Heritage Hills I hear this noise frequently. I greatly appreciate Centennial Airport taking this initial step to correct the adverse impact of the noise to our community. I would also request detailed, periodic reviews of plans and operational procedures with the acquisition and installation of a radar-linked noise monitoring system.

I would also strongly encourage that the FAA adopt the recommendation to fly a 170-degree departure heading for approximately 4 miles before executing a (+ or -) 20-degree turn. I would also appreciate this same standard for approaches to the airport.
